Legislative Advocacy: City & statewide work	Dedicated focus areas: Boston Newton Southeastern MA area
Art/Visual strategy	A collective of artists creates powerful visuals for Palestine protests, using art as a tool for resistance and awareness. They design banners, posters, murals, and digital graphics that amplify Palestinian voices and demand justice. This group currently primarily works with sister organizations' artists to produce art.
Political Education	A dedicated group of JVPB members who provide political education about Palestine through an anti-Zionist lens. They explore histories of resistance, solidarity, and Jewish traditions of justice, challenging dominant narratives that conflate Zionism with Judaism. Through workshops, reading groups, and public discussions, and film screenings, they provide critical analysis of settler colonialism, apartheid, and liberation struggles. Campus Organizing	A group of JVPB members who are active on college and university campuses for Palestine.
Media & Comms	A group of JVPB members who serve as communicators and social media strategists who work to amplify JVPB's message advocating for Palestine. They craft compelling content, manage digital campaigns, and counter misinformation to ensure accurate narratives reach a wider audience. Through graphics, videos, and strategic messaging, they mobilize support, engage communities, and keep the public informed about developments on the ground.
