1. Purpose & Scope

This handbook defines the core standards, expectations, and organizational framework for all Hekaton Private Security personnel.

It establishes the professional and military-style norms that guide how HPS operates in all theaters.

2. Core Values

- Discipline – Maintain control under pressure.
- Precision – Execute with accuracy in flight, fire, and communication.
- Reliability – Be where you're needed, when you're needed, every time.

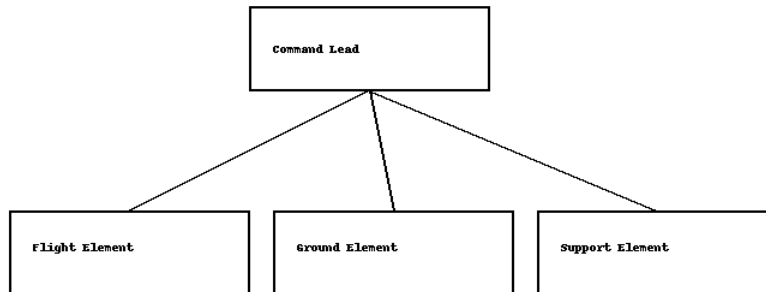
3. Organizational Structure

HPS is divided into Command, Flight, Ground Security, Support & Logistics, and Training & Compliance.

Command holds strategic authority; Flight and Ground execute tactical operations; Support sustains those efforts.

4. Standard Operating Picture (Diagram)

The diagram below illustrates the basic flow of command down to operational elements.



5. General SOP Overview

- Mission Preparation: Briefing, loadout, ship readiness, comms checks, contingency plans.
- Standard Communications: Clear, concise, and mission-focused callouts using HPS-approved brevity codes.
- Safety Rules: Weapons on safe until cleared; no unnecessary discharges; EVA safety tethers in hostile or debris-heavy zones.

6. Uniform & Visual Identity

HPS maintains a professional visual standard reflecting its role as a disciplined private security organization.

Armor color schemes, insignia placement, and ship markings should follow the HPS visual guide (to be appended).
