Overseas Progress Report Digital Form Specifications

I. File Format

Word (*.doc) or PDF file.

II. Layout Settings

A4 portrait size, with text written horizontally.

III. Cover Format and Settings (please refer to the template)

IV. Text Settings

The body of the text should be written in Standard *Kaiti* (12 pt, regular); all titles should be in Standard *Kaiti* (14pt, bold).

V. Image Processing

Images should be uploaded at a lower resolution to reduce the file size of the Overseas Progress Report for faster upload speed.

VI. Attachment Handling

Important, non-copyrighted documents brought back from abroad can be photocopied or scanned into PDF files and attached after the body text of the electronic document.

VII. Other Remarks

- The contents shall be arranged in the following order: cover, abstract (200–300 words), table of contents, and body text (and optional appendices). In addition, each page shall be numbered.
- The body text must contain the “Goals,” “Process,” as well as “Reflections and Recommendations” sections.
- The title of the Overseas Progress Report must express the purpose of the overseas project.
- If the list of members going abroad is too long to be listed on the cover, it can be shortened by listing only the team representative. However, a complete list of all members going abroad must be included later in the document.
