- 1. The Kaupeka teachers order 100 pieces of fish for the end of term celebration, but on the day only 90 students arrive at school for the day.
 - a) How many pieces of fish does each student get?
 - b) How many are left over? (What is the remainder?)
 - c) What is the remainder as a fraction, and a decimal?
 - d) Can you figure out what the remainder is as a percentage?
- 2. There were 49 long skipping ropes available at St Francis of Assisi for lunchtime skipping. If 5 people need to be in a group for skipping, how many groups can you have at the most at one time?
 - a) How many skipping ropes would remain?
 - b) Try the remainder as a fraction and a decimal.
