Welcome to your new Chromebook Plus! This new device offers a streamlined, fast, and secure experience, designed for modern teaching. This guide guickly outlines the key differences from your MacBook Air and provides essential first steps.



⚠ IMPORTANT: First-Time Setup Instructions

Your device must be unboxed and started on the school's network before you take it home. This is a critical step for the initial setup, device enrollment, and ensuring you have all necessary school resources and security policies installed.

- 1. **Unbox** your new Chromebook Plus. 🔥 If there are any papers on the charger please remove them.
- 2. **Turn it on** by pressing the power button. You will see it connect to LPSDprivate and then switch to LPSEmpDev. Once connected to LPSEmpDev, restart the laptop to install our policies.
- 3. **Sign in** with your school Google Account (your email address and password). Feel free to skip adding a pin.
- 4. Once you see the desktop and can open your web browser, the setup is complete. Your drive files, settings, and Chrome tabs will sync instantly and you can now take it home.

Chromebook Plus vs. MacBook Air: What's Different?

The biggest difference is the operating system. Your MacBook Air runs macOS, while your new Chromebook Plus runs ChromeOS High Royalty. We chose the Chromebook Plus specifically for its enhanced features which provide powerful advantages for educators:

Basic Functionality:

1. The Interface

- The Shelf: The bar at the bottom (similar to the Mac "Dock") be sure to pin your favorite apps.
 - ☐ Pin the Keyboard Shortcuts app
 - ☐ Pin the Explore App
- Launcher: Click the bottom-left circle icon (or press the Search/Everything key on the keyboard) to open the application list, search for apps, or search the web.
- Status Area (The Time/Clock): The bottom-right corner (similar to the Mac menu bar) shows your Wi-Fi, battery, and time. Click it to open the Quick Settings panel to adjust volume, brightness, and sign out.
- 2. Mouse/Trackpad Gestures
 - Right-Click: Tap the trackpad with two fingers simultaneously.
 - o Scroll: Place two fingers on the trackpad and move them up or down.

5 Top Row of Keys



- 0. Exits full-screen mode or closes dialog boxes.
- Goes to the previous page.

- Dims the screen.
- Brightens the screen.

🔖 Bookmarking Tips & New Tricks

- Chrome Settings > On startup > Continue where you left off
- Pin tabs you use everyday.
- Group tabs of things you always use together.
- Bookmarks bar
 - Use folders to organize bookmarks you want to save but do not use very often.
 - Keep names as short as possible for easy legibility (delete the name if the icon is enough to ID it.
 - Clean up the bookmarks once a month.
- TIP: Paste this into your URL bar and Bookmark the page to stay up-to-date on new features. chrome://whats-new/


- entire document when you navigate back to it. Quitting Chrome fixes the issue (until the next time you forget to close the popup Keyboard).
- Metapen USI 2.0 without a magnet (\$30 on <u>Amazon</u>) rechargeable battery. Staff noticed that the palm rejection feature does not work in Google Slides but does work in Cursive and Canvas.
- Penoval USI 2.0 magnetic (\$60 on <u>Amazon</u>) rechargeable battery. So far no notable glitches. Best pen for the artist.
- Stylus tools and apps
 - Laser pointer
 - Magnifying glass
 - Chrome Canvas App (drawing)
 - Chrome Cursive App (notebook)



Setting up the Uniflow Extension for Printing


1. Click on the white puzzle icon at the top right corner of Google Chrome.




- 2. Select 'uniFLOW Online'.

4. Click on 'O365-Azure'.




5. Close the Uniflow tab.



6. Click Print.






Chromecast to the Clear Touch Screen

- 1. Make sure the Collage app on your Clear Touch is up-to-date and has the correct settings.
 - a. <u>Updating Collage Video</u>
 - b. Note: Make sure that "Allow Chromecast device" is checked off in settings.
- 2. Click on the Status Area of your chromebook (lower right corner).



3. Click on cast screen



- 4. Click on the correct clear touch from the list.
 - a. Check the collage settings on the Clear Touch to see what you need to be looking for
- 5. Troubleshooting:
 - a. Make sure collage on the clear touch is up-to-date and has the correct settings
 - b. on your CB+ toggle WiFi off/on
 - c. Temporary solution: switch your CB+ WiFi to LPSDprivate (Our network manager is actively diagnosing the need to do this sometimes and should resolve this soon.)
 - d. Restart both the Clear Touch and your CB+

Protecting your New Laptop (optional)
