

Privacy Policy for Network Insight: 5G & Wi-Fi

1. Introduction This Privacy Policy describes how **Network Insight: 5G & Wi-Fi** ("we", "our", or "the App") handles your information. By using the App, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

2. Information Collection and Use To provide professional network diagnostic features, the App requires access to specific device data:

- **Location Data:** Per Android system requirements, **Fine Location** access is required to perform Wi-Fi scans and retrieve Cellular Tower Information (RSRP, SINR, PCI). This data is processed locally on your device in real-time and is **not** stored on our servers or shared with third parties for tracking purposes.
- **Device Information:** The App accesses technical details such as your IP address, Wi-Fi SSID, and signal metrics to display network performance.

3. Third-Party Services (Advertising) The App uses **Google AdMob** to display advertisements. AdMob may collect and use certain data, such as your **Advertising ID**, to provide personalized ads.

4. Data Security We value your trust in providing us your information. We do not collect personal identifiers (like names, emails, or phone numbers) within the app. All network analysis is performed on-device.

5. Permissions Justification

- **ACCESS_FINE_LOCATION:** Required to identify Wi-Fi networks and Cell Tower IDs.
- **ACCESS_WIFI_STATE / ACCESS_NETWORK_STATE:** Required to monitor signal strength and connection quality.
- **INTERNET:** Required for AdMob and map tile loading.

Important: The "Prominent Disclosure"

Google Play now requires a "**Prominent Disclosure**" *inside* the app before you even ask for the location permission.

What to do: Create a simple Dialog that pops up the first time a user opens the app. It should say:

"Network Insight requires Location access to perform Wi-Fi and 5G signal scans. This data is used only for real-time diagnostics and is not shared or stored."
