

## Beanstack Logging Instructions (using Classlink)


- 1. Log into Classlink <a href="https://launchpad.classlink.com/pasadenaisd/">https://launchpad.classlink.com/pasadenaisd/</a>
- 2. Look for the Beanstack icon



- a. Click on the Beanstack icon
- b. Click on the red button that says, "Log Reading"




c. It will say "What do you want to log?" Click Log Pages



- d. Select the day you read the pages or finished the book.
- e. Enter the Title
- f. Enter the Author


- g. Finally, enter the number of pages you read.
- h. Click the red button that says Log


1. Download the app from Google Play or the App Store




2. Open the app. When you open the app, you will see the following screen;



a. Click Let's Go!




b. Next, choose the first option - At my library, school, or bookstore.



c. Click Find a Site.

- d. Search for the school you attended in 2021-2022
  - i. For example, if you are a 6th grader and attended Melillo, you will search for Melillo.
- e. Then click on the school and it will bring you to the Pasadena ISD log in page.




f. Student Number = Your first and last initial + your student ID number with the 0

Example: mn0123456


g. Password: Your last name in lowercase letters

Example: nicol

h. When you are in the app, you will click the blue + sign at the bottom of the screen.




i. Then choose Reading




j. Then search for the title of the book.



k. Then you will confirm the title.



I. Then you choose Log Reading



- m. Finally, you fill out the number of pages you read or you toggle if you finished the book.
- n. Finally, click the done button!
