<u>Attendance</u>

Attendance at <u>all</u> events (sectionals, rehearsals, performances) is <u>mandatory</u>. HCPSS Policy 8090: Non-School Hour Participation Requirements for Elementary and Secondary Curricular Programs states that events scheduled during non-school-hour activities mandated by a curricular program are <u>required</u> of the student participant.

HCPSS Policy 9010: Attendance states that a lawful absence may include any of the following conditions:

- Death in the immediate family
- ❖ Illness of the student
- Court summons
- Hazardous weather conditions
- Work approved or sponsored by the school
- Observance of a religious holiday
- State emergency

- Suspension
- ❖ Lack of authorized transportation
- Other emergency or set of circumstances which, in the judgment of the Superintendent
- or designee, constitutes a good and sufficient cause for absence from school

Absence due to pre approved activities must be communicated via email at least two weeks in advance of the absence.

Absence due to illness or emergency must be communicated via email before rehearsal begins.

Missing more than one rehearsal per concert cycle for any reason will be cause for review and may result in the ensemble member's dismissal from the ensemble.

Music Preparation

Gifted & Talented ensemble members are expected to practice and learn the selected music at home. Rehearsals are not for note learning. We reserve the right to dismiss the student for insufficient preparation of the music.

Students' seating will be determined after the seating audition each semester. The Directors may change students' seats based on performance, behavior, or what is best for the ensemble at any time.

Rehearsal Expectations

Ensemble Members must attend the entirety of every rehearsal and performance. Students should arrive <u>no later than 4:05pm</u> so that rehearsals can begin promptly at

4:15pm. A student who arrives at 4:15pm is late. Students who are late once will be given a verbal warning. A second offense will warrant a call home and a request that parents/guardians arrange for transportation to be timely. Tardiness is cause for dismissal.

Rehearsals end promptly at 6:15pm and parents/guardians must pick up their children **EXACTLY** on time.

Inclement Weather Policy

The following inclement weather policy will be utilized:

- 2 Countywide no school due to inclement weather = **NO rehearsal**
- Countywide early dismissal due to inclement weather = <u>NO rehearsal</u>

Materials for Instruction

Upon arrival to all rehearsals, it is the responsibility of each ensemble member to have the following items in their possession: pencil, tuner, and your music (not your stand partner's).

Instrument Security & Identification

It is the responsibility of each ensemble member to take their instrument to/from each rehearsal. Each instrument should have an identification tag that includes: student's full name, student's school, type of instrument, phone #, and email address.

Uniform

It is the responsibility of each ensemble member to provide the specified items to be worn for the performance:

- Black long-sleeved button-down shirt or other black dress shirt. NO t-shirts.
- Black slacks or a long-length skirt. NO jeans or leggings.
- Black dress shoes and black socks. NO tennis shoes.

Code of Conduct

The ensemble members are expected to follow general school rules at all times. In addition, the following behaviors will not be tolerated:

- Disrespect to peers, adults, chaperones, staff, or performers
- Use of electronic devices
- Playing instruments or touching equipment other than your own
- Use of profanity

All members are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct at all times. Failure to obey these expectations may result in the following disciplinary action:

- 1. A warning will be given to the ensemble member from the ensemble director(s)
- 2. A conference between the parent/guardian and ensemble director(s) will occur
- 3. Removal from the ensemble will occur without refund of the yearly fee.

Extreme circumstances may result in immediate movement to step 3 at the discretion of the directors and/or the HCPSS Coordinator of Music.

Payment Information

A non-refundable payment of \$350 is required for participation in this ensemble.
