MLB: Philadelphia Phillies vs Miami Marlins - 1 Unit (-130) - 6:40pm ET

Phillies to win

Analysis:

Although the Marlins have been playing better ball, the Phillies are favored to win based. Taking a look at the data, they have a strong 37-21 record when listed as the moneyline favorite, which translates to a 63.8% win rate, and an even higher 71.1% when favored at -130 or shorter odds. This consistency shows they tend to perform reliably when odds are favorable. Conversely, the Marlins have only managed a 39% success rate as underdogs, winning 23 of their 59 such games, suggesting they are capable of pulling off surprises but lack the same level of consistency. Overall, the Phillies' solid record as favorites and their current winning streak make them the likely winners, while the Marlins will need to capitalize on their opportunities to challenge that expectation. **The public also likes the Phillies holding 80% of the ML bets and 92% of the money on them winning the game outright.**

Analysis:

The Pacers have been resilient all postseason, going 5–0 straight-up and against the spread after a loss, and Coach Rick Carlisle continues to make impactful adjustments—implementing zone looks and full-court pressure that have disrupted OKC's rhythm. Indiana's bench, especially Bennedict Mathurin and T.J. McConnell, gives them a scoring and tempo edge that's hard to match. While the Thunder pulled away late in Game 4, their reliance on free throws (34 makes) and rebounding (43–33) masked a poor 3-point shooting night (3-for-16), exposing their vulnerability if Indiana cleans up fouling and hits open looks. Game 3 proved the Pacers can win outright when their pace and depth are firing, and given their proven ability to keep things tight, they're well positioned to stay within the number—even in a tough road environment. **The public favors Indiana in tonight's game on both bets placed and money which are sitting at 68% and 65%.**
