

Welcome to our Minecraft-themed Indi Sphero adventure! These slides will help us remember what each colour tile does, with a fun Minecraft character to match!

### Slide 1: Green Tile - The Energetic Creeper!

- **Colour:** Green
- **Indi's Action:** Start / Increase Speed
- **Minecraft Character:** The Energetic Creeper!
- **Why:** He's ready to go, go, go! When Indi lands on green, he's like a Creeper getting ready to chase, moving forward quickly and speeding up.

### Slide 2: Yellow Tile - The Cautious Bumblebee!

- **Colour:** Yellow
- **Indi's Action:** Decrease Speed
- **Minecraft Character:** The Bumblebee!
- **Why:** This fluffy, yellow friend loves to fly around, but when it's time to land on a flower or gather pollen, it slows down gently.

### Slide 3: Blue Tile - The Helpful Allay!

- **Colour:** Blue
- **indi's Action:** 90° Right Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Helpful Allay!
- **Why:** Allays are known for collecting and carrying items, often taking a winding but direct path to their destination. When **indi** lands on this blue block, it's like an Allay taking a sharp right turn to find and retrieve a lost item, making a precise change in direction to get around obstacles.

### Slide 4: Pink Tile - The Pink Axolotl

- **Colour:** Pink
- **Indi's Action:** 90° Left Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Axolotl
- **Why:** Sometimes, these colourful sheep like to wander off in unexpected directions, taking a sharp 90-degree turn to the left to find a new patch of grass.

### Slide 5: Teal Tile - The Sly Guardian!

- **Colour:** Teal
- **Indi's Action:** 45° Right Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Guardian!

- **Why:** These aquatic mobs have a distinctive teal colour and are always patrolling monuments, often making slight, precise turns as they keep watch.

## Slide 6: Orange Tile - The Crafty Terracotta Shard!

- **Colour:** Orange
- **Indi's Action:** 45° Left Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Terracotta Shard!
- **Why:** Found in Mesa biomes, these orange blocks, when broken, can sometimes represent a slight shift in direction or a small piece breaking off as you mine, requiring a slight turn.

## Slide 7: Red Tile - The Unmovable Redstone Block!

- **Colour:** Red
- **Indi's Action:** Stop
- **Minecraft Character:** The Redstone Block!
- **Why:** This block powers circuits and acts as a strong, solid anchor. When Indi lands on red, it's like activating a Redstone block to bring everything to a complete stop.

## Slide 8: Purple Tile - The Enchanting Obsidian!

- **Colour:** Purple
- **Indi's Action:** Celebrate
- **Minecraft Character:** The Enchanting Obsidian!
- **Why:** This powerful, dark purple block represents something magical and special. When Indi lands here, it's like the world celebrates a successful enchantment with lights and sounds!

What a brilliant way to connect the real world of coding with the digital world of Minecraft! I love the idea of using the characters' personalities to define the **indi** bot's actions. This makes the learning experience so much more creative and memorable for the students.

Here are some Minecraft character-themed ideas for all the **indi** colour tiles, complete with a reason for each connection.

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## Minecraft-Themed **indi** Character Blocks - Attempt 2 below in GEM

- **Colour:** Green

- **Indi's Action:** Start / Increase Speed
- **Minecraft Character:** The Energetic Creeper
- **Why:** The Creeper is ready to go, go, go! [cite\_start]When **Indi** lands on green, it's like a Creeper getting ready to chase, moving forward quickly and speeding up. This block is the core of any mission.
- **Colour: Yellow**
  - **Indi's Action:** Decrease Speed
  - **Minecraft Character:** The Busy Bee
  - **Why:** Bees are methodical and buzz along at a steady pace. [cite\_start]When **Indi** lands on yellow, it's like encountering a busy bee, slowing down its pace to navigate carefully. This is perfect for moving through a crowded space.
- **Colour: Red**
  - **Indi's Action:** Stop
  - **Minecraft Character:** The Redstone Circuit
  - **Why:** Redstone is the ultimate power control! [cite\_start]A Redstone block is used to power circuits and stop pistons. When **Indi** lands on red, it's like the power is cut, bringing it to a full stop.
- **Color: Purple**
  - **Indi's Action:** Celebrate / Dance
  - **Minecraft Character:** The Ender Dragon's Victory
  - [cite\_start]  
**Why:** Defeating the Ender Dragon is the ultimate victory in Minecraft, deserving of a great celebration! When **Indi** lands on a purple tile, it spins around and makes music, just like the feeling of triumph.
- **Color: Blue**
- **Indi's Action:** 90° Right Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Helpful Allay!
- **Why:** Allays are known for collecting and carrying items, often taking a winding but direct path to their destination. When **Indi** lands on this blue block, it's like an Allay taking a sharp right turn to find and retrieve a lost item, making a precise change in direction to get around obstacles.
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- **Color: Pink**
  - **Indi's Action:** 90° Left Turn
  - **Minecraft Character:** The Wandering Trader
  - **Why:** The Wandering Trader is known for taking unexpected and winding

paths. [cite\_start]When

**indi** lands on pink, it makes a sharp left turn, like a Wandering Trader going down a hidden path to a new location.

- **Color: Teal**

- **indi's Action:** 45° Right Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Enderman's Gaze
- **Why:** Endermen are cautious and will often turn slightly away from you. [cite\_start]The teal block gives **indi** a subtle turn, like avoiding a direct gaze, perfect for a minor course correction.

- **Color: Orange**

- **indi's Action:** 45° Left Turn
- **Minecraft Character:** The Blaze's Fireball
- **Why:** Blazes in the Nether are always adjusting their aim to hit their target. [cite\_start]This block allows **indi** to make a small, precise turn, like a Blaze lining up a fireball, to correct its path.
