- 1. Classwork (15%)
  - Each MP Grade is worth the same and is determined by the Check System

## **Check System**

• Your MP Grade is determined by the following equation:

$$MP\ Grade = rac{Your\ Check\ Points}{Total\ Check\ Points}$$

• Total Check Points is determined by the following equation:

Total Check Points =  $(Total Powerpoints Covered in MP) \times 1.5$ 

\*Exception is Term 2, MP3 (details in May)

- There are two types of HW: HW form and Unit Check
  - They usually done on google forms

### Late Point Counter

- Everyone starts with 50 points
- For each late assignment:
  - o HW deducts 1 point
  - Unit Check deducts 3 points
  - Review HW deducts **5** points (spring term)
- At the end of the term: Each missing assignment, deducts 10 points
- \*Points will be deducted unless
  - Valid excuse like medical (non-repeating)
  - You can notify Mr. Kan ahead of time if valid reasons
- \*There might be optional opportunities to get more points

## In-Class check

- Not assigned often, only when it is necessary
- Can be announced or random
- A small amount of exam questions during class.

- Exams consists of multiple choice and free-response. Usually 32-38 questions depending on unit.
- Absent note/reason is needed for makeup without penalty. Makeup should be done in a week.
- Unexcused school policy (1st time 25% off, 2nd time - 50% off, 3rd time – 0 as a grade)
- Depending on Department policy, an uniform or in class final may\* counts as 20% or 1 exam.

## 4. Lab + Effort (10%)

#### Lab Work (5%)

- Grade is made up of completing labs, safety, etiquette. Everyone must wear goggles.
- It is out of 10 points.
- Ignoring lab safety and not wearing goggles will results in lower lab grade
  - Deduct 0.1 to 1 point based on frequency and severity
- You need a total of 1200 min of lab work + 3 mandated labs.
- If you missed labs, I will tell you if you need to go to remake up sessions
- Updated after each lab

### Effort (5%)

- Based on work ethic, behavior and conduct in Lab work and Classwork
- It is out of 3 points. 1 point for each Marking period
- Points gained (0.1 to 1) based on effort and conduct in **both** Lab and Class
- Updated towards the end of the term
