

Grade Breakdown

1. Classwork (15%)

- Each MP Grade is worth the same and is determined by the Check System

Check System

- Your MP Grade is determined by the following equation:

$$MP\ Grade = \frac{Your\ Check\ Points}{Total\ Check\ Points}$$

- Total Check Points is determined by the following equation:

$$Total\ Check\ Points = (Total\ Powerpoints\ Covered\ in\ MP) \times 1.5$$

*Exception is Term 2, MP3 (details in May)

2. Homework (15%)

- There are two types of HW: HW form and Unit Check
 - They usually done on google forms

HW Form	Unit Check
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on 1 powerpoint• Graded by completion• They consist of mostly multiple-choice questions• You have unlimited tries to get 100% for hw before the deadline.• After the deadline, you cannot edit after submission• If you miss HW, you have to notify me to get it graded. (*late point counter)• Worth 1 HW point	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on 1 Unit• Graded by correction• They consist of mix multiple-choice and free response questions• You will have about a week to complete• After the deadline, you cannot edit after submission• If you miss Unit Check, you have to notify me to grade it. (*late point counter)• Worth is based on the # of powerpoints in the Unit

Late Point Counter

- Everyone starts with 50 points
- For each late assignment:
 - HW deducts **1** point
 - Unit Check deducts **3** points
 - Review HW deducts **5** points (spring term)
- At the end of the term: Each missing assignment, deducts **10 points**
- *Points will be deducted unless
 - Valid excuse like medical (non-repeating)
 - You can notify Mr. Kan ahead of time if valid reasons
- *There might be optional opportunities to get more points

3. Assessment (60%)

- Consists of exams + in-class Check

Exams	In-Class check
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A full-period test will be given after each unit of study (approximately every 2 weeks).• Date of exam is on Jupiter and Calendar	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not assigned often, only when it is necessary• Can be announced or random• A small amount of exam questions during class.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exams consists of multiple choice and free-response. Usually 32-38 questions depending on unit. • Absent note/reason is needed for makeup without penalty. Makeup should be done in a week. • Unexcused school policy (1st time – 25% off, 2nd time - 50% off, 3rd time – 0 as a grade) • Depending on Department policy, an uniform or in class final may* counts as 20% or 1 exam. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Counts as fraction of an exam (based of number of questions)
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4. Lab + Effort (10%)

<p style="text-align: center;">Lab Work (5%)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grade is made up of completing labs, safety, etiquette. Everyone must wear goggles. • It is out of 10 points. • Ignoring lab safety and not wearing goggles will results in lower lab grade <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Deduct 0.1 to 1 point based on frequency and severity • You need a total of 1200 min of lab work + 3 mandated labs. • If you missed labs, I will tell you if you need to go to remake up sessions • Updated after each lab 	<p style="text-align: center;">Effort (5%)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Based on work ethic, behavior and conduct in Lab work and Classwork • It is out of 3 points. 1 point for each Marking period • Points gained (0.1 to 1) based on effort and conduct in both Lab and Class • Updated towards the end of the term
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
