## A BILL

TO ENSURE EMPLOYMENT TO ALL NECESSARY PERSONS IN THE UNITED STATES

---

Be it enacted by the House of Representatives, and by extension, the sole legitimate legislature of the United States, the following.

1. The creation of the Department of Works Progress
2. Is given 4,450,000,000 U.S.D. for the purchase of office space and other assorted establishment necessities before the budget of F.Y.2045 enters force
3. Is directed to construct, starting April 1, 2046,
  - a. A hydroelectric dam on the Colorado river
  - b. High speed Rail, connecting the following in a singular system:
    - i. Boston
    - ii. New York City
    - iii. Washington D.C.
    - iv. Richmond
    - v. Baltimore
    - vi. Chicago
    - vii. Minneapolis
    - viii. Columbus

- ix. Kansas City
  - x. Bismark
  - xi. Los Angeles
  - xii. San Francisco
  - xiii. Salem
  - xiv. Seattle
  - xv. Austin
  - xvi. Atlanta
  - xvii. Houston
  - xviii. Boulder
  - xix. Miami
  - xx. Nashville
  - xxi. New Orleans
  - xxii. Little Rock
  - xxiii. Tulsa
  - xxiv. Pittsburgh
  - c. 80 Uranium Nuclear Reactors for energy production
  - d. An additional bridge connecting Brooklyn and Manhattan
  - e. 4 aerodromes in Missouri, as seen fit by the DWP, for settlements without air connection
- 4. The Secretary of Works Progress is given cabinet level status.
  - 5. The Department of Works Progress is to be given a overall audit every 3 years, supplementing normal audits.
