

Step-by-step instructions to record Skype calls in GarageBand '11 w/ Soundflower & Lineln

- I. **Download and install Soundflower and Lineln** (*Soundflower requires a restart*)
- II. **Open GarageBand**
 - A. Select "New Project" then "Voice"
 - B. Open GarageBand > Preferences...
 1. Audio/MIDI
 - a) Audio Output: Leave as Default or System Settings
 - b) Audio Input: Soundflower (64ch)
 - C. command+i to open Track Info (*probably already open*)
 1. Track 1 (*Skype track*)
 - a) Input Source: Mono 1 (Soundflower (64ch))
 - b) Monitor: On
 - c) Select "No Effects"
 2. Track 2 (*Local track*)
 - a) Input Source: Mono 3 (Soundflower (64ch))
 - b) Monitor: Off
 - c) Select "No Effects"
 - D. Open Track menu
 1. Select "Enable Multitrack Recording"
 - E. Arm both tracks for recording (*press the red dots*)
 - F. Turn metronome off (*May already be off. Icon should be grey, not blue*)
 - G. Save project and leave GB open
- III. **Open Skype**
 - A. Open Skype > Preferences...
 1. Audio/Video
 - a) Speakers: Soundflower (64ch)
- IV. **Open Lineln**
 - A. Select Settings drop down menus
 1. Input & Output settings
 - a) Input: Default System Input
 - b) Output: Soundflower (64ch)
 - (1) Advanced... (*under both Input & Output menus, choose either*)
 - (a) Input: Default
 - (b) Output: Left=3, Right=4
 - B. Enable "Play Thru"
- V. **Open System Preferences**
 - A. Select "Sound"
 1. Input
 - a) Internal Microphone (*or whatever you're using*)
 2. Output
 - a) Headphones, Internal Speakers (*or whatever you're using*)
- VI. **Open Audio MIDI Setup** (*In Utilities, or type Audio MIDI in Spotlight*)
 - A. Make sure Built-In Microphone and both Soundflower volume values are all max (1)
- VII. **Start Recording** in GarageBand
- VIII. **Make Skype call** (*See sidebar comment if there's no audio*)
