3	Immigrant greater than 3 years	

- All students born in any State will have an Immigrant Indicator of "0" (Not an Immigrant), where
  the term 'State' means each of the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and the Commonwealth
  of Puerto Rico.
- All students not born in any State will have an Immigrant Indicator other than "0" (Not an Immigrant), where the term 'State' means each of the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
- Code 1 definition First time enrolled in a U.S. public school for less than one year.
- Students with code 1 or 2 will be used for Title III funding.

## Where to enter Immigrant information in Infinite Campus:

- Immigrant information is based on a Student's Birth
   Certificate. It should tell you in what country they were born.
- At this time, Birth Country is not reported to NDE, however it may be soon.
  - In IC go to the Student's Person Page
  - Enter Birth Country and Dates
- Enter Immigrant information on the Student's Enrollment
  - Go to the State Reporting Fields Section
  - Enter the appropriate Value
    - Student's default to 0
    - Hopefully you will know if this is the first US school they are attending. In some cases, they will also have EL information.
    - If a student transfers in and has been in the US for more that 3 years, enter a 3.
