Senate Procedure Autonomy Amendment

Preamble:

Whereas the president can currently veto votes by the senate on senate procedure (such as the creation of a committee), they shall no longer be allowed to do that with this amendment.

Section 1: Constitutional Amendments

- §1. Article 1 of the constitution shall have a new clause that states:
 - §8. The senate shall have the right to determine its own procedures.
 - §8.1. The senate must follow any legislation guiding senate procedures.
- §2. Article 4 Clause 2 of the constitution shall be stricken and changed to:
 - §2. The President shall have the authority to veto any votes passed by the Senate within three (3) days of their passage, with the exception of confirmations, votes on internal senate procedure, impeachments, and constitutional amendments.
 - §2.1. The Senate may override a veto with a two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) majority.
