Online Rounds Platform

We are using ZRM for the online rounds and will send out the link the day before competition.

Most rooms listed on the pairings will have both a physical and an online version. The only rounds that will not have online counterparts will be those between in-person teams with an in-person judge. If you are an in-person team debating an online team you can set up in the in-person room and login to the online room. If you are an in-person judge assigned to a hybrid round you should not physically judge in the assigned room if the in-person team is using it. You are welcome to judge from anywhere else, and we have also booked Jepson 120 for this purpose.

Tech Issues During Online Rounds

Most of the time tech issues can be caught quickly (you might notice a screen freeze, for example – good reason to keep screen on) and resolved without significant time spent.

Tech Time is unique to online issues and can only be invoked in those situations where we are having problems in the virtual spaces. It does not apply to your inability to send an email or other problems you might encounter in an in-person round. Participants should clock and report its use immediately. Judges - y'all know this so don't be part of the problem here.

In the event of a tech failure by a team, a team may use up to 10 minutes of "tech time". This should be clocked by the judge, and not used as standard prep time. It is only for use with tech/connection/AV issues unique to the online format (not for setting up your email chain, e.g.).

The judge should notify the tab staff asap if tech time is invoked, or if the judge themselves have a tech issue, so that the tab staff can factor that into scheduling.

Judges should have cameras ON.

Hospitality Room

Walking Directions to Campus from Hotels

If you are a pedestrian from Courtyard Marriott: walk across the Division Street bridge to cross the river. Immediately after you cross the River take a sharp right as if you were going to go behind the River Inn. You'll see a little path that leads to the river path (you can see the river path when you are crossing the bridge). The path will take you under Division Street, past the River Inn (will be on your left) and then you'll see campus on your left. Before you get to the Lake (on campus, to your left) cut north through campus. The easiest way to find College Hall is to look for the spires on top of the St. Al's Church. They have big crosses on them and are difficult to miss. College Hall is located next to St. Al's.

Parking

The best place on campus to park is the College Hall parking lot on the northern side of College Hall. You do not need a parking pass and security will not ticket you even though it is a marked lot. Since it is a weekend there should be plenty of parking available in that space.

Smoking Policy

Not in Buildings (This isn't the 80's). Gonzaga does not allow smoking (including vaping/e-cigarettes) in any building.

Not Near Entrances (This isn't the 90s). Gonzaga complies with the Washington State Clean Indoor Air Act, by prohibiting smoking and the use of e-cigarettes in all Gonzaga buildings, and within 25 feet of any entrance, exit, window, or ventilation intake.

Drugs/Alcohol Policy

Not allowed on campus. While it is true that marijuana is legal in our state, it is not allowed on campus due to restrictions placed on federal funding Gonzaga receives. So feel free to exercise your freedoms while in our state, just not on our campus.
