A Few Things to Get Ready:

We also recommend arriving about 15 minutes early so we can keep everything on time—especially since we often have more parties scheduled that day!

Please no confetti or pinatas.

Party Timeline:

Arrival + Gifts + Cupcakes & Punch (75 minutes):

Get here a few minutes early to welcome your guests. Once checked in, we'll escort everyone to your private Splatter Spot party room—fully set up with tablecloths, napkins, glow cups, glow plates, cupcakes, glow balloons, birthday banner, and punch!

🎉 We set up place settings for the number of Splatter participants you reserved (for example, if you booked for 8, we'll have 8 spots ready). Need to add a few guests? Just give us a call **at least a week ahead** and we'll do our best to accommodate!

This is your time to relax, open gifts, mingle, sing "Happy Birthday," and soak up the celebration!

Quick Clean-Up & Splatter Prep (10 minutes):

After the cupcakes are devoured and the gifts are opened, we'll clear the room and prep the **Splatter Spot**. During this time, participants will head to the lobby to gear up in ponchos, shoe covers, and goggles. We'll snap a few fun pics and go over everything you need to know.

👶 Children 5 and under must have one supervising adult in the room with them (don't worry—we'll provide their gear, too, and there's no charge for that adult).

🔥 **Splatter Spot Session (30 minutes):**

LET'S SPLATTER! This is what you've been waiting for—get ready for the wildest, most colorful birthday celebration EVER!

Each participant gets their own canvas and nearly **half a gallon of vibrant splatter paint**, plus some of our coolest splatter tools and tricks.

👁️ Family and friends can watch the action live on our lobby screen.

Prepare to laugh, splash, and make memories you'll never forget!

🍹 Adults: We've got beer, wine, Nutrl, soda, and water available for purchase to keep the celebration going (no outside alcohol, please).

🧼 **Clean-Up & Goodie Bags (5 minutes):**

By now, the splatter participants may look like a walking rainbow—so we've got sinks (and even a hose outside LOL!) to help rinse off before heading home.

🎁 Every participant gets to take home their custom canvas and a fun party favor.

While you're here, check out our shop filled with local art, handmade gifts, art supplies, and cool Pineapple Picasso swag. And don't forget to sign up for one of our amazing art workshops—we offer everything from resin art to painting!

🍕 If you ordered pizza from Il Primo, we will deliver it for your party. If your party starts at 10am, it will arrive around 10:30am when Il Primo opens.

FAQ

Q: Can I bring other food or drinks?

A: You are very welcome to bring other food or drinks. We only ask that you don't bring alcohol because we serve it in the store.

Q: Do I have to order Il Primo Pizza from you?

A: No, but we won't deliver it for you. We are only connected to Il Primo and only offer large cheese, pepperoni, or sausage. We deliver Il Primo for you.

Q: Can I bring a cake?

A: Yes, but you will need to bring your own plates (you will still have plates from us for the amount of splatter participants and pizza if you ordered it from us), silverware, and cutting utensils. We serve cupcakes so we don't have to have utensils.

Q: Can I bring other decorations?

A: Yes, but keep in mind that they will need to be removed from you before we go into clean up for the splatter part of the party.

Q: Can we come early?

A: We ask that you come at least 15 minutes early to greet your guests as they come in. Many times we have back-to-back parties, and we are still setting up before you arrive.

Q: Do I have to pay for anyone that is attending the party, but not doing the splatter portion?

A: You only pay for the splatter participants. We only set up the tables for the amount of splatter participants. For the first portion of your party, you are welcome to have anyone back in the rooms with you, even if they are not doing the splatter part.

Q: What if I have a very young child doing the splatter portion?

A: If you have anyone under 5 years of age, one adult must do the splatter portion to supervise. You do not have to pay for this participant.

Q: Do we get to watch what is happening in the Splatter Spot?

A: Yes, there are cameras in the rooms, and those not participating can watch the action on the lobby screens.

Q: What happens if my child is not enjoying the Splatter Spot?

A: In the Splatter Spot, paint does get sprayed EVERYWHERE, including sometimes in the face. We provide goggles, ponchos, and shoe covers for this very reason. The paint is very safe

and is harmless. If you think your child will not enjoy this, please do not send them in. If we see that they are not enjoying it and want to come out, we will do our best to bring them out. Keep in mind that there are usually several people in the blacklight Splatter rooms, and we may not see that they want out right away. Anyone not suited up for protection in the Splatter rooms, may not go in.

Q: Do we have to wear ponchos?

A: No. Some people opt for our white t-shirts or bring their own. Some people still wear the poncho and put the t-shirt over it. You do still have to wear the goggles and shoe covers.
