Heartland Swim Club is a year round USA Swimming program. This team is open to any and all elementary/ middle school/ and high school students of any schools in the surrounding area. One of the few requirements to be able to join is the athletes ability to swim across the pool, in our case a 25 meter pool. By doing so, that athlete will be placed in 1 of the 3 groups we offer. Gold, (typically high school and middle school students) Silver, (middle school, elementary students) and Bronze, (elementary students). If your athlete does not qualify, HRSC has the plans in place to start up a swim lessons program in the near future.

Volunteer Commitment

Unlike other clubs, as of now there are no volunteer requirements. However, there may be situations or events where we need to provide volunteers. Please be willing and or flexible as we navigate HRSC first couple seasons.

Apparel

- Team Suits are required for Swim Meets
- Team Caps are required for both Practices and Swim Meets

All swimmers will receive a team shirt and a latex swim cap. At the start of each season, families will have the option of ordering additional team shirts via our spirit wear order through Elsmore. Additional swim caps may be purchased at any time from a coach. The cost of an additional Latex cap is \$5 and Silicone \$10, if you would simply like to upgrade from latex to silicone (the one you get at the beginning of the season) it is \$5 with the trade in.

Equipment/ Gear

The gear requirement for each group is different and will be dependent on the coach of that group. Tipton High School has all the gear that would be needed that your athletes may borrow and keep at the school (unless we are scheduled to go to the City Pool) and returned at the end of the season. If you wish to purchase your own equipment and need recommendations, please contact your group's coach.

Communication

 and coaching staff. In the event practices are cancelled or moved for any reason, all participants
 should be enrolled in the app and is provided at the call out meeting as well as on our team

Meet Requirements

All swimmers are required to attend 4 out of the 7 meets we have scheduled this Short Course Season. This does include championship meets if your swimmer has obtained a cut. Failure to attend the 4 meets will result in a \$50 fine (max of \$200). For High Schoolers the minimum meet count is 1.

REGISTRATION/MEMBERSHIP FEES

All swimmers will be required to pay two registration fees:

- Heartland Swim Club (\$100) or (\$60 for SCY/ \$60 for LCM)
 Heartland Swim Club will assess this fee on 1st statement of the season
- USA Swimming Registration Fee (see USA SWIMS Website)
 Members must register with USA Swimming. Heartland Swim Club will provide a registration link shortly after paperwork is processed.



CLUB SWIM FEES

We encourage all families to pay the full amount of Club Fees at registration. To try to make that easier we offer a 10% discount on Club Swim Fees for each swimmer whose fees are paid in full at registration. For those who choose not to pay in full, we offer an installment plan for paying the fees.

Multi-Swimmer Discount

We offer a multi-swimmer discount on Club Swim Fees. The discount is per swimmer and is applied to the amounts listed above:

2 swimmer: 5% for second swimmer
3 swimmer: 10% for third swimmer
4 swimmers: 15% for 4th swimmer

SPLASH FEES

Splash fees represent the cost of swimming in a meet and are based on the swimmer's participation and the nature of the meet. These will include entry fees and even fees. These costs mentioned are NOT part of registration but rather are billed after each meet and are due the following month. Price Range from anywhere between \$20 - \$60 depending on the meet format and number of events registered for.
