Locker Request

Students who wish to have an assigned locker should complete the <u>Locker Request Form</u> Lockers are only assigned to students who complete the Locker Request Form. Once the form is completed, Mrs. Lacy-Garner will assign lockers and send students an email with their assigned locker number and lock combination. Most student lockers will be on the 1400 hallway, where students enter and exit the building. Students in the Culinary Arts Program of Study will have priority for lockers on the 1300 hallway near the Culinary Classroom/Kitchen. Students can begin requesting lockers immediately.
