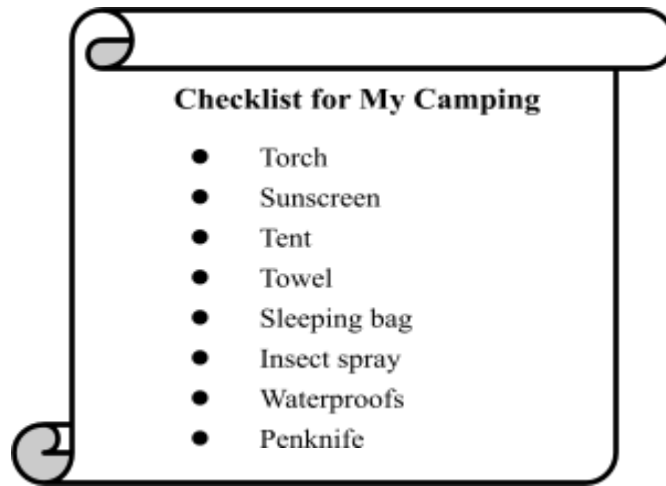

Python Found in Car Boot in Dungun

A	Carriages In the past, a carriage was used to transport things and people. It was a vehicle with wheels that's usually pulled by horses. In some cities, you can go for a carriage ride through the park. A single horse could pull a wheeled vehicle and contents weighing as much as a ton. Transporting people and goods was difficult in the 19th century as animals required large quantities of food and water to provide primary means of transportation all over the world.
B	Telegraph The telegraph was developed in the mid-19th century by Samuel Morse. The term came from the Greek words <i>tele</i>, meaning at a distance, and <i>graphien</i>, meaning to write. It was a device or system that allows the transmission of information through coded signal over distance. It was mostly used to communicate between ships at sea.
C	Pot A simple vessel made of earth and water, the pot was one of the oldest and most valuable tools. The discovery that clay could be formed into a container and baked until hard allowed people to carry, cook, serve and store their food. Without the pot, we never would have roamed far from sources of fresh water and wouldn't be able to preserve food to get through famines and harsh weather.
