Additional Points

	Items Permitted	Items not Permitted
Jewellery	Students are not permitted to wear jewellery to school. Religious jewellery may be worn out of sight.	No other forms of piercing are allowed. No other jewellery should be worn.
Hats and Scarves	Woollen hats and scarves are permitted outside in the winter. Black blue or grey hair bands.	No other hats are allowed on the school site (including baseball hats)
Coats	Students should wear a coat that is waterproof and can protect them from the weather. They should be large enough so that the school blazer can be worn underneath.	Zip up tops and cardigans, with or without hoods

PE Uniform

For P.E. students must wear:

- a grey polo shirt with school logo*
- a navy long sleeved top with the school logo (optional)*
- navy shorts or track suit bottoms (shorts can be bought from school)
- trainers
- navy socks

The items that need to be bought from school can be ordered by post or by email (uniform@heartlands.haringey.sch.uk) and collected from school, or bought directly from school.

Equipment

Being equipped to learn, both physically and mentally, is really important if we are to maximise learning and progress. Lesson time should not be wasted or disrupted by students trying to acquire equipment.

Students must bring in a suitably sized school bag, big enough to fit in books and A4 work. Tutors and other teachers will issue detentions if students do not have them. Repeated failure to bring in the correct equipment will lead to a central detention.

To be properly equipped for lessons students need to bring the following:

- Student Planner
- Reading Book
- Calculator
- Pens x2, Pencil, Ruler, Rubber
- A dictionary
- PE kit on the appropriate days

Please put the Student's name on all items of uniform and kit.

Outdoor clothing

Students must ensure that all outdoor clothing, including their coat, is removed as they enter the building.

Students out of uniform

Students who arrive to school without the correct uniform will be asked to change straight away by the teacher on the school gate. If students are able to go home and collect uniform and the school can contact parents then we will ask students to return home to collect missing items of uniform.

We expect all students to arrive ready to learn. If this becomes a pattern (i.e. this occurs 2 times in a short period of time) then further sanctions will be implemented.

Students who persistently arrive without their proper school uniform (i.e. 2 times within a short period of time) should have their sanction escalated.

Where students are out of uniform all teachers have a responsibility to ensure that issues are resolved. Where matters cannot be resolved, teachers will refer students to their tutor and in more serious cases to the Head of House. Students should not be left to walk around school out of uniform.
