Welp, I guess Seth can now change his team name to BEST OF THE WORST, because he was officially given the title after beating Alex this week, 152.8-124.8.

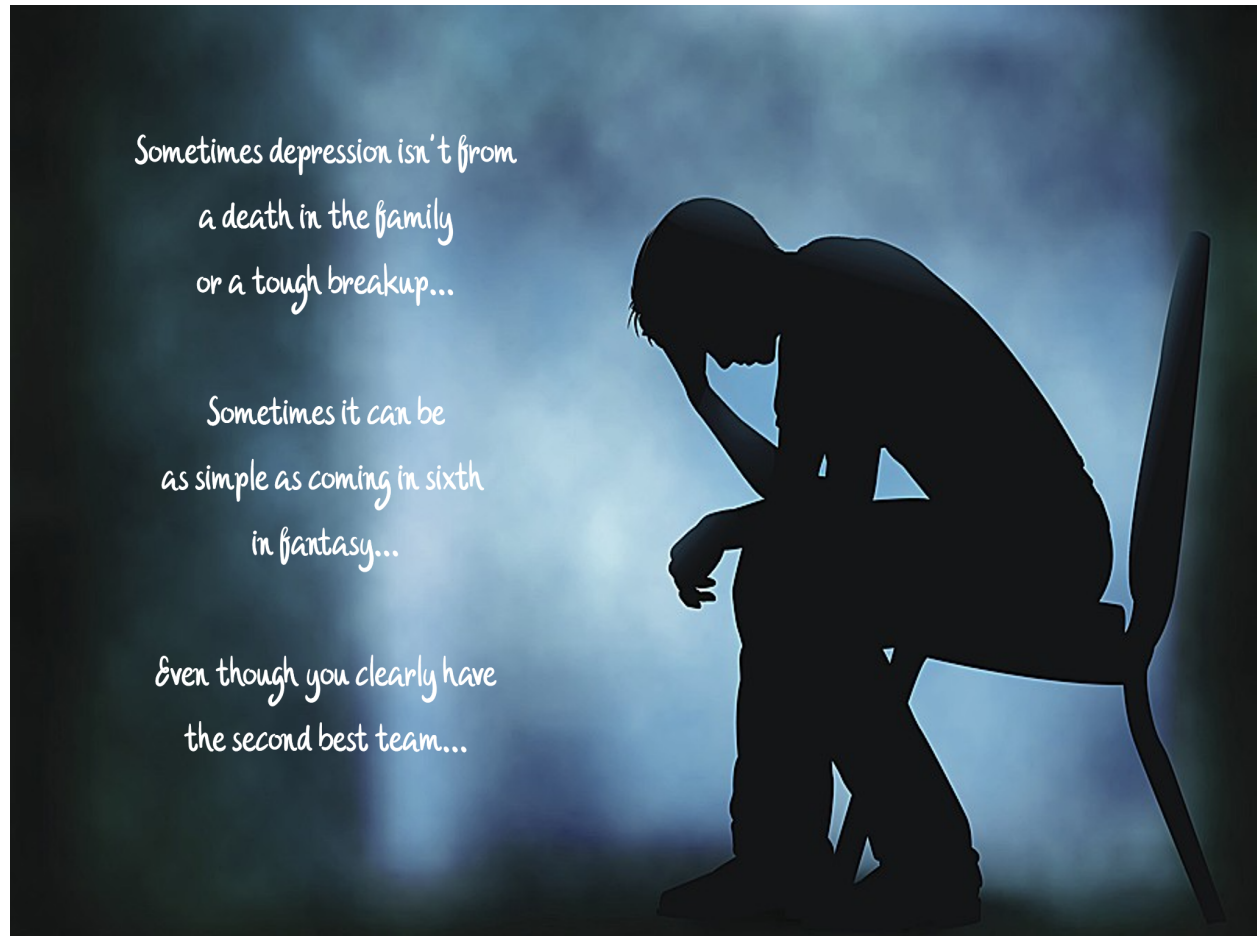
Let's start with Seth.

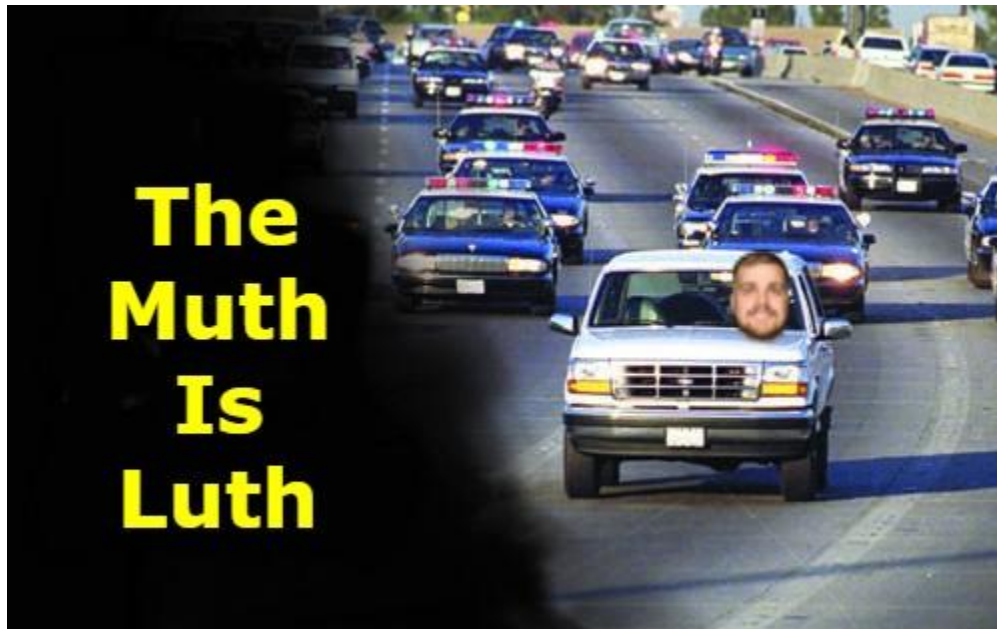
