Information from our School Nurse:

If your student is new to the Pennsville School District, please fulfill the proper requirements for the Health Office (recent school physical and up to date immunizations).

Please remember to bring in all forms for the nurse: asthma action plan, food allergy plan, and medication forms.

Parents must bring in any medication; it cannot be sent in with students.

Please make certain that your child dresses appropriately for the weather; otherwise, they may not be able to participate at recess. Also, please label hats, gloves, and coats so that we can determine who they belong to if they end up in our "Lost and Found".

During the winter months, we encourage you to dress your child in a few layers. Students have varying thresholds in regard to feeling cold, comfortable, or hot. This will allow students to have some control over maintaining a level of comfort while in school.

<u>A Reminder to Parents of 5th Grade Students</u>: Please send in documentation of the required immunizations for 6th grade as your child receives them at their 11 year well visit.

<u>Appropriate Footwear</u>: Please make sure your child brings a pair of sneakers with him/her on days he/she chooses to wear open-toed shoes or flip flops to school so they can be worn for recess and physical education.

<u>Head Lice</u>: Supervising your child's hygiene and head inspections are important. Lice outbreaks are common among children and even the cleanest child can easily become infested. It's important that you routinely inspect your entire family because lice are becoming increasingly difficult to eliminate.

Illness: Please remember to keep your child home if they aren't feeling well. You can call 856-540-6200 ext. 7600 at any time to report your child absent.

Reminders:

Students should not arrive at school prior to 8:05 AM as we do not have supervisory personnel prior to this time. A latch-key program is available for parents in need of before and/or after school care.
