Exhibition Overview

Artists throughout the United States are invited to submit original artwork for consideration in the Winterville National Juried Small Works Exhibition 2026. This exhibition celebrates outstanding contemporary artwork in a wide range of media while encouraging the collection and appreciation of small-scale works.

Important Dates

Call Opens: August 1, 2026

Submission Deadline: August 30, 2026

Notification of Acceptance: September 12, 2026

Artwork Delivery: Shipped work -September 23, in person by September 24–26, 2026

Exhibition Dates: October 7 – December 15, 2026

Opening Reception: October 9, 2026

Exhibition Closes: December 15, 2026

Eligibility

Open to artists 18 years of age or older residing in the United States. Original two-dimensional and three-dimensional artwork is eligible.

Accepted Media

Painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, ceramics, sculpture, fiber, mixed media, and other original fine art media.

Size Requirements

Artwork may not exceed 14 inches in any direction, including frame. Three-dimensional work may not exceed 14 inches in height, width or depth.

Entry Fees

Members: \$25 for up to three entries

Non-Members: \$35 for up to three entries

Sales and Commission

All accepted artwork must be available for sale for the duration of the exhibition.

Artist: 65%

Winterville Cultural Center Gallery: 35%

Shipping and Delivery

Artists are responsible for all shipping and return shipping costs. Return shipping must be arranged by December 17.

Submission Requirements

Up to three artworks may be submitted.

JPEG format only.

Images should be cropped to artwork edges.

File size limit: 2 MB.

AI-generated artwork is not eligible.

No reproductions or giclées.

Artwork must be original and completed by the submitting artist.

Presentation and Installation Requirements

Wall-mounted work must be ready to hang with secure wire.

No sawtooth hangers.

No screws, nails, or fasteners may be installed into gallery walls.

No ceiling-mounted installations.

No floor anchoring systems without prior approval.

Jury Process

All entries will be reviewed by Yu-Kai Lin, who will select the artwork included in the exhibition and determine award recipients.
