

SRHS Junior Articulation – Support Document 2025

Directions for Articulation Card – You must also complete the on-line course requests

- ✓ Read the [Course Descriptions](#) on srhscounseling.com under Academics
- ✓ READ THE RECOMMENDED PREREQUISITES FOUND IN THE COURSE DESCRIPTION
- ✓ Talk to current teachers, teachers who instruct the classes you are interested in taking next year, and current juniors about class recommendations
- ✓ Do not ask teachers for written recommendations — they are submitted directly
- ✓ Use progress grades, teacher recommendations (given to students verbally when asked), and end-of-course exam scores (if available) for consideration of class choices
- ✓ Keep in mind your overall time commitments (sports, family responsibilities, work, community service, rigor of classes etc.) when choosing classes!
- ✓ After completing your Articulation Card, log in to PowerSchool → Class Registration → follow the directions then and SUBMIT.

• Area A- History/Social Sciences

Modern World History 1,2	US History 1,2
Modern World History 1,2 with Grade A	US History 1,2 <u>OR</u> Honors US History 1,2
Advanced World History 1,2 with Grade A or B	Honors US History 1,2
Advanced World History 1,2 with Grade C	US History 1,2
Advanced World History 1,2 with Grade A and Grade A in Advanced English 3,4	AP US History
AP European History with Grade A or B	AP US History

• Area B – English

Current Course	Recommended Course
English 3,4	American Literature 1,2
English 3,4 with Grade A	American Literature 1,2 <u>OR</u> Honors American Literature 1,2
Adv or Seminar English 3,4	Honors American Literature 1,2 <u>OR</u> AP Language & Composition
Adv or Seminar English 3,4 with Grade C	American Literature 1,2

• Area C - Math

- o You must have 6 credits of Mathematics on your SRHS transcript for high school graduation.
- o Request the next class in progressive order. **Skipping math courses is not recommended**
- o End of year grades and score on the end of year exam (if available) will verify appropriate math class placement.

• Area D - Science

- o You must complete 3 years of science for high school graduation: 1 Physical Science (Physics or Chemistry), 1 Life Science (Biology), and 1 Additional Science Course (can be physical or life).
- o If pursuing a **STEM major** or **competitive university**, you should complete Physics, Biology, Chemistry AND a 4th year of science.
- o CCTE Pathway students may substitute an approved pathway science course for the third-year requirement.

Biology: The Living Earth 1,2	Chemistry Earth System 1,2
Advanced Biology 1,2 with Grade A or B	Chemistry Earth System 1,2 <u>OR</u> Honors Chemistry 1,2
Advanced Biology 1,2 with Grade C	Chemistry Earth System 1,2
AP Biology	Honors Chemistry 1,2
AP Biology with Grade C	Chemistry Earth System 1,2

* If you have already taken Chemistry, review the [science options chart](#) and course descriptions for guidance.

- **Area E - Language Other Than English (LOTE)**

- 2 years of the same language are required for graduation and college entry
- 3+ recommended for UC and some private schools
- Go to "[Graduation Requirements](#)" under Academics on the SRHS Counseling website to see alternative ways to meet the LOTE requirement

Areas F, G and Other Electives

Number your 6 elective course options across areas F, G, Other Electives and College classes in order of preference (1–6). Review and understand the [CCTE Pathways Sheet](#) before making your selections.

Bolded classes on the Articulation Card = Pathway Courses. If you take a Concentrator Pathway class in 10th or will in 11th, you must take the pathway Capstone course prior to graduating.

Completing Online Requests: When completing your elective course requests online, enter ONLY as many electives as needed to equal 6 classes. Any extra electives you list on your card will be used as alternates if your top choice electives do not fit in your schedule.

- **Area F – VAPA.**

- Must complete 1 year of a VAPA course in grades 9-12

- **Area G - College Prep Elective and Other Electives.**

- Only one year of a "G" elective is required for graduation and college admission. The following courses meet the G elective requirement: Math courses higher than Integrated Math 3; A third year of a Language Other than English (LOTE); Courses listed in Area G on your Articulation Card

- **Athletics and PE**

- If participating in an SRHS sports team, choose **Athletics (6th period)** and indicate your sport on your Articulation Card
- If you haven't completed 2 years of PE, enroll in PE, PE Dance, AFJROTC, Athletics, or Marching Band

- **Assigned Time Home – You may request a shortened day only if you meet the following:**

- Completed 24 credits by end of sophomore year
- Minimum 2.75 cumulative 9-12 GPA
- Enrolled in at least one Advanced, Honors, AP, CCTE class w/possible college credit, or a college class
- Complete the required paperwork available on the [Class Applications](#) page of the SRHS Counseling website under the Academics section.

- **College Classes (Dual Enrollment)**

- Must meet recommended prerequisites and maintain good attendance and citizenship
- College classes appear on your permanent college transcript
- College courses will be taught in-person or synchronously at a specific log in time during school hours
- REQUIRED: Attend the Community College Info Session in the spring. Exact date and time TBD

Keep in mind your overall time commitments (sports, family responsibilities, work, community service, rigor of classes etc.) as the master schedule is developed based on your requests!

Course changes are not guaranteed. Choose the courses that are right for you and make your selections thoughtfully **the first time.**

Share all articulation materials with your parent/guardian.
