HOW TO APPLY

BEFORE YOU APPLY

FIND A PROGRAM PROVIDER:

- WorkReady Summer programs are hosted by 90+ "program providers", including local afterschool agencies, community non-profits, rec centers, etc.
- Use the Program Locator (QR code) to find a program provider near you.


GATHER YOUR VITAL DOCUMENTS:

- You will need your vital documents to confirm your identity, proof of your address, and your age. Forms of identification may include a [State-issued ID card](#), [Social Security card](#), or your [birth certificate](#).
- Contact your program provider or PYN directly with any question on how to obtain your vital documents.

Step 1 -

- Visit www.workready.org/summer and click the application link that corresponds to your status
- RETURNING APPLICANTS:**
 - If you participated in a PYN program in the past year (2022/2023), you already have an account! Your username is whatever email you used to apply last year.
 - Check your email. You should have received information on how to get your login credentials.
 - If you forgot or can't access your email, contact your previous program provider or contact the WorkReady Hotline to get your password.
- NEW APPLICANTS:**
 - Select "Create a new account" and create a new username and password.

STEP 2 -

FILL OUT YOUR PROFILE + JOB APPLICATION:

- Once you have logged in, select your job application age range and complete your profile and application.
- You must fill out all required fields fully!**
- Don't forget to include the program code that corresponds to the program provider you are applying for.

To ensure easier placement, we highly recommend all applicants use the Program Locator to identify provider codes for programs that interest them. Visit workready.org to access the Program Locator and find the right program for you

STEP 3 -

CHECK YOUR EMAIL FOR THE NEXT STEPS

- Once your profile and application are complete, you will be contacted via email regarding the next steps and what documents you will need to submit to be eligible to start your summer job!
- If you do not receive an email within ~1 month, contact your provider or the WorkReady Hotline.

STEP 4 -

UPLOAD YOUR DOCUMENTS + COMPLETE PAPERWORK

- Once your worksite has confirmed your participant application, you will be required to submit certain documents to become eligible for payments.
- Upload your vital documents and complete any paper work on your applicant checklist.
- Ask your program provider or contact the WorkReady Hotline if you have any questions or are having difficulty accessing your documents!

* NOTE - Some worksites may require proof of COVID 19 vaccination and/or other additional clearance documents prior to starting.

STEP 5 -

FINALIZE ONBOARDING + CONFIRM YOUR START DATE

- Finalize all your paper work and double-check with your provider to make sure you have completed all the steps required to participate and that you are prepared to start working.

REMEMBER - IT IS UP TO YOU TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE COMPLETED ALL THE STEPS REQUIRED TO ENROLL. IF YOU HAVE NOT COMPLETED ALL THE STEPS AND CONFIRMED YOUR STATUS YOU CANNOT GET PAID!
