- History of UnionHall
 - LaborWeb -- original tool from 2007-2017
 - UnionHall -- complete rebuild to second version from 2017 to present
 - **UnionHall 2.0 -- complete rebuild to newest version launched in summer of 2022 (migration required)**
- Templated website tool for state and local organizations (most current drupal)
- National Unions can have their own branded version of UH 2.0 for their locals
- Syndicated content to local sites
- Ease of use
- Ongoing support and training

- Mobile friendly

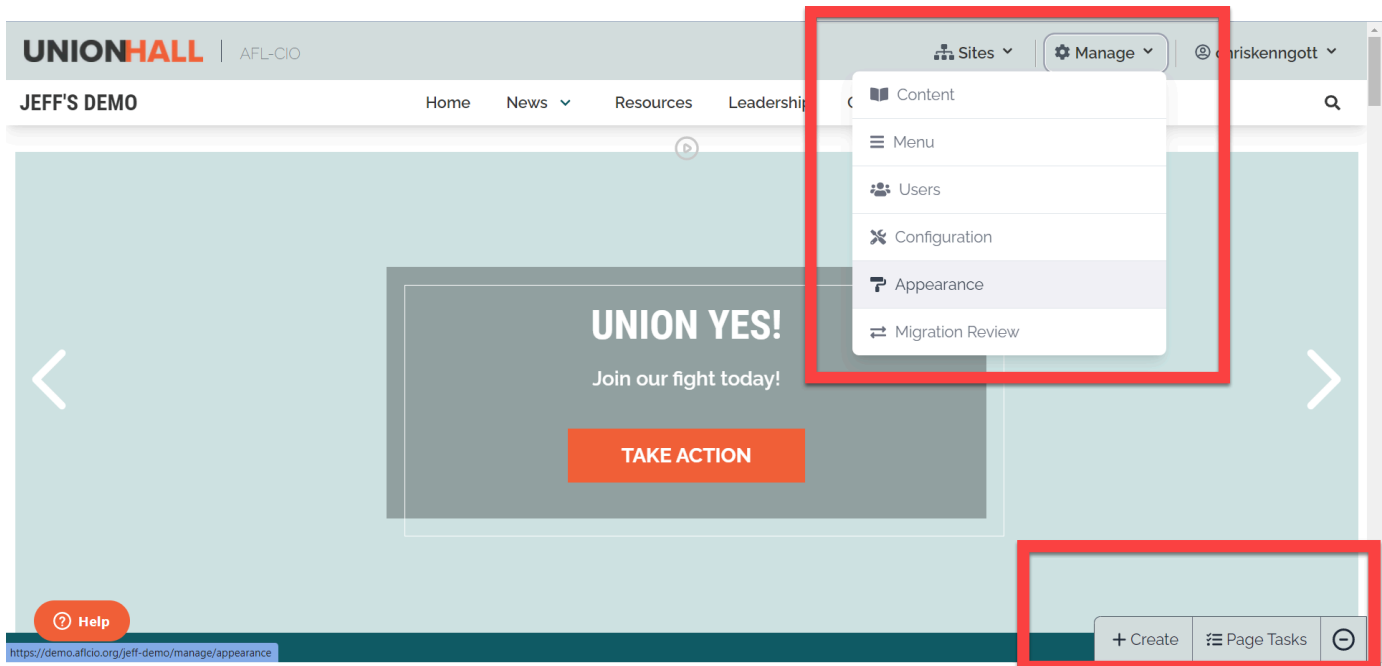

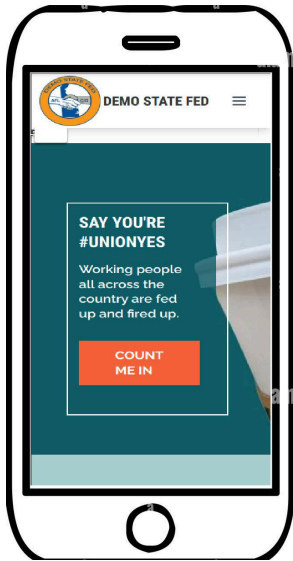

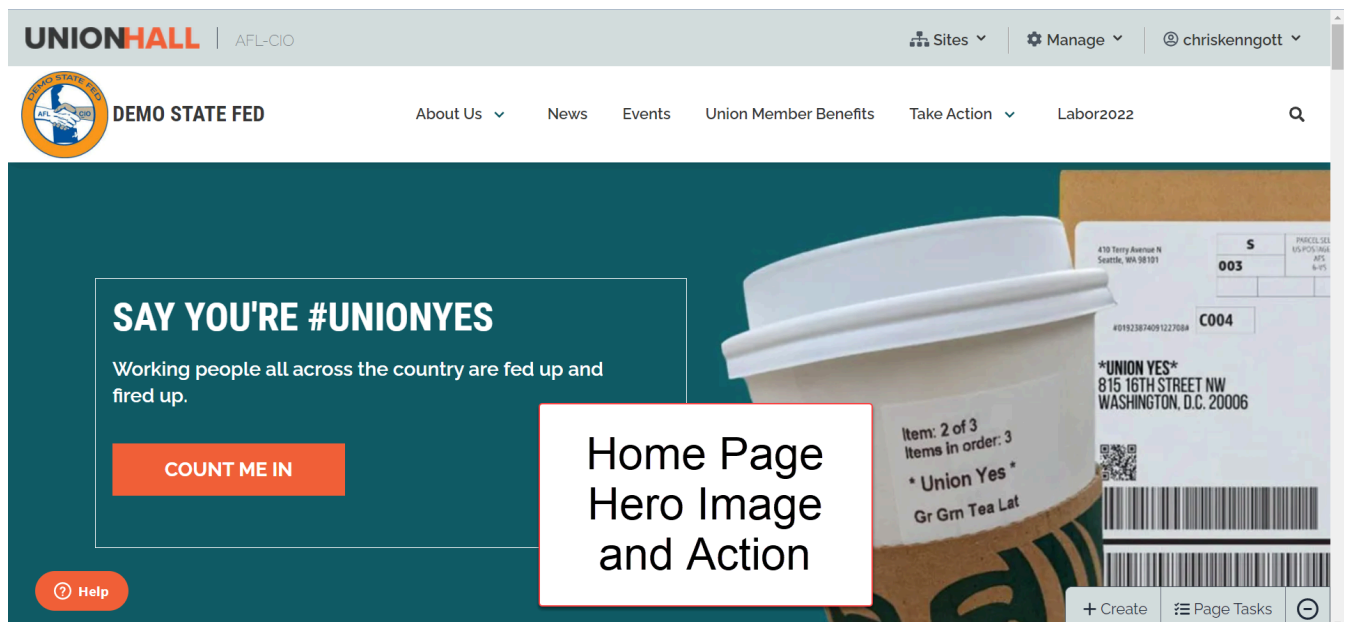
- Autosave - edits are autosaved every 60 seconds.
- User interface - content tasks are now easier.
 - Create content menu remains in the lower right
 - Site tasks have been consolidated under the manage menu in the top right.



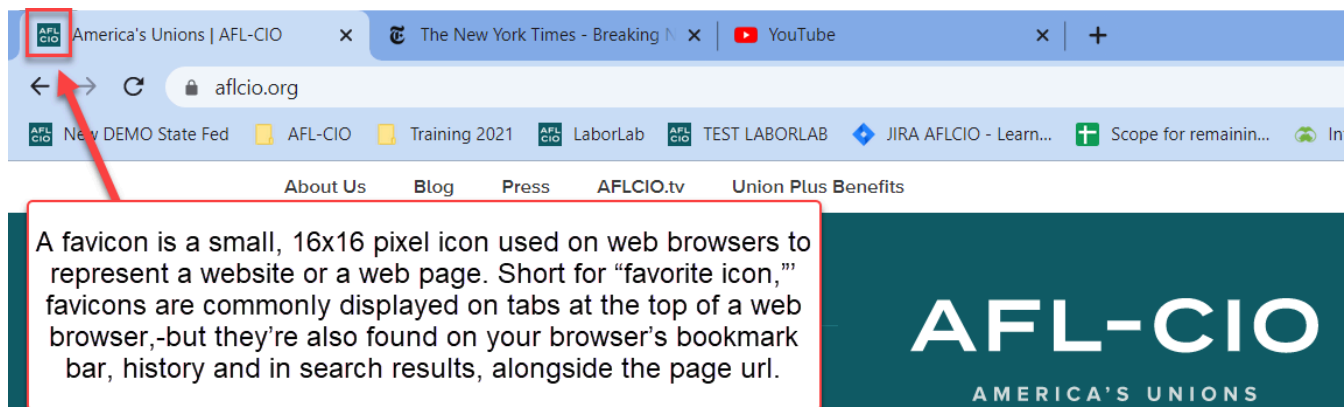
- Mobile Admin - Make changes from your mobile devices.



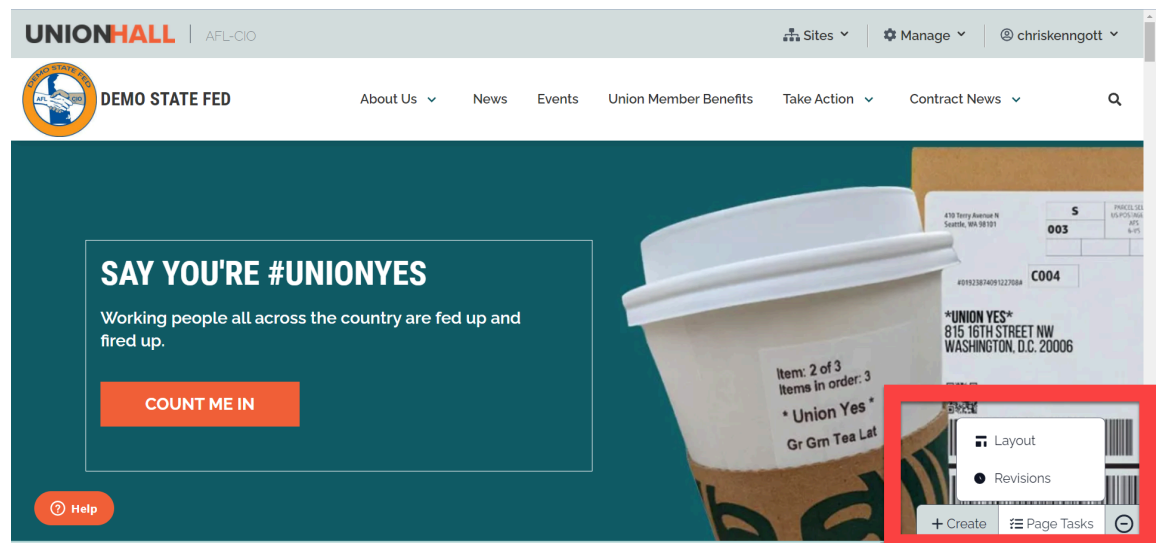
- Hero Space (home page image and action)
 - Carousel Slider of images on your main page
 - Easy to add and remove



- Favicon - Ability to add your own.



- Site Tags - Add custom tags to create custom page listings, easy to group topics.
- Page Builder -- (Advanced Feature)
 - Easily add media including photo galleries
 - Create your own page layout
 - Create Image Libraries
 - Hero Carousel



- Private
 - Private site -- mark as private to require user authentication

- Private content on public site easily create content sections that can only be viewed by approved members (members only sections)
