**FROM THE GOLF COURSE:**

When River Hills Country Club first opened many years ago, white 4 X 4 posts were used to designate property plot borders as well as the Out of Bounds (OB) markers for players on the course. Over time, trees, bushes and other plantings grew and impeded sight lines from one OB stake to the next one. The club has installed smaller 1" X 1" white stakes throughout the golf course so that golfers could better see to determine if their balls are in or out of bounds. These new stakes are now the **official** boundaries for OB on the course and **SHOULD NOT BE MOVED!** Thank you for your attention to this matter.

**SOUTH POINT PARK BATHROOMS:** Bathrooms will be winterized and closed for the season. We will reopen them just before Easter when there is no chance of freezing weather. Plan your visits to the park accordingly! 😊
