- Feature cases no unpacking or unboxing it all rolls in
- 45 different table-top modules that all slide out all pre-setup
- Fair takes 2 people 20 minutes total to setup
- No posters
- Specific book fair that targets economically-challenged schools all \$5 & below (hoping in the next year) - let Follett know if you are interested

South Carolina Teaching Standards (SCTS) 4.0

Every student in South Carolina schools deserves an effective teacher. Teachers deserve timely, thoughtful feedback about their practice to grow and develop at all stages of their professional career. The Expanded ADEPT Support and

Evaluation System represents a significant step in the journey of improving teacher professional practice for the benefit of ALL students in South Carolina.

The primary goal is to use evaluation as a tool that informs an educator's professional growth and development, with emphasis on the direct connection between teacher practices and increased student learning through the incorporation of student academic growth measures into classroom-based teachers' evaluation. Revisions in our current system are intended to align and strengthen professional practice to support the intended student outcomes.

Introduction to South Carolina Teaching Standards

As part of the *Expanded ADEPT* system, South Carolina Teaching Standards (SCTS) 4.0 is South Carolina's primary formal evaluation model for classroom-based teachers. The SCTS 4.0 rubric is based on sets of performance standards designed and validated by the National Institute for Excellence in Teaching (NIET) and establishes the expectations for what classroom-based teachers are to know, be able to do, and carry out as an integral part of their practice. These expectations, called the SCTS Indicators, are the foundation for good teaching and are designed to grow classroom-based teachers throughout their career continuum, beginning with teacher preparation and continuing through Induction, summative performance evaluations, and ongoing professional growth and development. A classroom-based teacher's proficiency in each of the standards is expected to occur developmentally and to increase continuously throughout the entirety of the teaching career.

The SCTS 4.0 rubric is *not* intended to be used to evaluate special area personnel, including library media specialists, school guidance counselors, and speech-language therapists. They will continue to be evaluated under the existing 2006 ADEPT guidelines.

Log into Destiny > Catalog tab > TitleWave > SUBMIT




<u>Updating Enrollment in TitleWise</u> – The items per student for TitleWise and TitleMap are calculated based on the enrollment #s provided in TitleWave. To update enrollment, contact info, Call # prefixes and ignored items:

TitleWave > Your Account > TitleWise Analysis > View > Settings > Edit > Finish

<u>Defaulting Destiny Discover</u> - Switch your students and teachers to the newest Destiny Search interface, Destiny Discover.

Destiny > Back Office > Access Levels. Edit each access level you'd want to be set to Destiny Discover. Under Library Catalog Search Access, check the following box for each desired access level: **Use Destiny Discover by default**

<u>Destiny Discover Google Chrome Extension</u>- While performing a Google search using Chrome browser, your library materials will appear at the top of the search screen. Here's a sample Google Search for Westward Expansion:



<u>Browse by Topic Search in Destiny Discover</u> – the default Browse Topics are elementary. Secondary schools will want to change to more age appropriate topics.

While logged into Destiny Discover as Admin > MENU (top left) > Setup > Maintenance > Setup > Scroll down to Browse by Topic and click on GEAR button. Toggle to Middle/High > OK > SAVE at the bottom of the next page. You'll need to log out and re-enter to see the changes. Secondary topics will include: Horror, Dystopian, Mythology and Romance.
