This Digital Signage Template has been designed to help your school easily communicate your Qustodio offering to parents. Follow the steps below to create a customised sign that directs parents to your school's dedicated resources on the Qustodio Parent App.

1. Create a copy of the Qustodio Digital Signage Template:
 - [Open the template link.](#)
 - In the top-right corner, click on **File** and select **Make a Copy** from the dropdown menu. This will create a copy that you can edit and customise.

2. Update the QR Code:
 - Delete the placeholder QR code by clicking on it and pressing the Delete key.
 - Go to **Elements** on the left-hand sidebar, and type **QR Code Generator** in the search bar.
 - Select **Use App** when prompted.
 - Enter the **URL** for your school's Qustodio Parent App article in the Online Safety Hub.
 - The app will generate a **new QR code**; place it in the designated area on the template.
3. Save your customised template:
 - When you're finished editing, click the **Share** button in the top-right corner.
 - Select **Download** and choose **PNG or PDF** as the file format for high-quality sharing.
4. Display the signage digitally:
 - Upload the final file to the school's TV displays or digital boards. Place it on screens in high-traffic areas like the main lobby, parent waiting areas, and hallways to ensure parents can easily see and scan the QR code.
