



## PJAIT grade scale

Polish Grade	Percentage	Definition
<b>5,0 (bdb)</b>	<b>80-100%</b>	<b>EXCELLENT</b> – outstanding performance with only minor errors
<b>4,5 (db+)</b>	<b>75-79%</b>	<b>VERY GOOD</b> – above the average standard but with some errors
<b>4,0 (db)</b>	<b>70-74%</b>	<b>GOOD</b> – generally sound work with a number of notable errors
<b>3,5 (dst+)</b>	<b>65-69%</b>	<b>SATISFACTORY</b> – fair but with significant shortcomings
<b>3,0 (dst)</b>	<b>60-64%</b>	<b>SUFFICIENT</b> – performance meets the minimum criteria
<b>2,5 (ndst+)</b>	<b>50- 59%</b>	<b>FAIL</b> – some more work required before the credit can be awarded
<b>2,0 (ndst)</b>	<b>0-49%</b>	<b>FAIL</b> – considerable further work required

Some courses are not evaluated with grade, only **PASS / FAIL** state.  
Eg. of such courses: physical education.

**NZAL – NOT PASSED / FAIL**
