Vocational Certification	 a. This degree is given by a college upon completion of an undergraduate studies program, it usually takes 4 years to complete.
Associate's Degree	b. Provides an intensive, focused training that prepares learners for work in a specific trade such as plumbing or vet technology. Some programs can take as little as 6 months to complete.
Bachelor's Degree	c. This degree is granted, after a two-year course of study, by a community or junior college.

HOME HEALTH AIDE

Duties: Assist clients in daily selfcare tasks, transport to doctor's office and keep clients company

Other Requirements: certain training hours, varies by state

MASSAGE THERAPIST

Duties: Evaluate clients' ailments, manipulate muscles, provide clients with guidance on stretching, strengthening, and relaxing body

Other Requirements: Licensing Examination (MBLEX)

VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATION

COSMETOLOGIST/ BARBER

Duties: Provide hair and beauty services to clients, maintain cleanliness of environment

Other Requirements: Active license from Barber or Cosmetology school

Average Hourly Wage: \$13-\$20 (varies greatly by location)

BACHELOR'S DEGREE

COMMUNITY SOCIAL WORKER

Duties: Understand clients' needs, connect clients to resources in the community, write grants, raise funds

Other Requirements: may require additional certification after Bachelor's

Average Hourly Wage: \$25

CARPENTER

Duties: Build, install, and repair structures made of wool, steel, and concrete

Other Requirements: 4-years onthe-job training

Average Hourly Wage: \$21 Apprentice \$36 Journey-person

ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE

OPERATING ENGINEER

Duties: Drive and control heavy machinery used to build roads, bridges, and buildings

Other Requirements: Valid driver's license and 3-4 years of on-the-job training

Average Hourly Wage: \$27 Apprentice \$45 Journey-person

PLUMBER

Duties: Work on heating, water, or drainage systems in homes, businesses, or factories

Other Requirements: 5-years onthe-job training

Duties: Calculate the time, money, materials, and labor required for construction projects
