The Ministry of Infrastructure and Sustainable Energy (MISE) will be implementing Sub-Component 2.3 of the Kiribati Outer Island Transport Investment Project (KOITIIP). This sub-component is dedicated to the rehabilitation of selected causeways located on Beru, Nonouti, and Tabiteuea South islands.

The rehabilitation work will be carried out using the Force Account approach. In light of the numerous competing priorities faced by MISE, including those from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the World Bank (WB), an agreement has been reached to establish new positions within MISE to provide support for the successful execution of the rehabilitation project. These positions will be supported by ADB and WB under the KOITIIP for a three-year period, following which they will transition into permanent roles within MISE.

As part of this process, MISE is now inviting eligible individuals to express their interest in the following positions:
