

22 years of English Language Theatre in Prague - the Fringe returns to its May dates!

Tickets are on sale now for the Czech Republic's very own slice of Edinburgh on the Vltava!

From Monday 22nd - Friday 27th May audiences can enjoy over 130 performances of 35 productions from 13 different countries around the world! The traditional (and not so traditional) theatres and performance spaces of Prague's Malá Strana district will once again be filled with international, often award-winning, ground-breaking theatre, comedy, children's shows, story-telling and more.

The festival team have curated an incredibly diverse range of options for audiences to enjoy - from The Bubble Show and Strictly Come Barking for family fun, to late night Dizney in Drag and Shane's Singo: Musical Bingo!

Returning favourites such as Pip Utton, and comedy duo Jon & Ollie are back, as well as brand new work from fresh, young performers and producers including our largest range of European shows from Poland, Serbia, Italy and Sweden, and even Ukraine.

Prague Fringe Founder and Director Steve Gove says "After three years we are finally back to our May dates and once again back in the beating heart of the Fringe - Malostranska beseda. Of course we never stand still, so we have introduced a new comedy venue too in association with our new accommodation partner Charles Bridge Hostel and Apartments. Long live Fringe!"

The festival is back in its favourite Malá Strana venues including Divadlo Inspirace, A Studio Rubín, Museum of Alchemists and Café Club Míšeňská. Plus this year sees 2

big changes - the introduction of a brand-new venue The Charles Bridge Comedy Club) which is hosting a full programme of stand-up and comedy shows, and the triumphant return of the beloved Malostranská beseda for the larger-scale productions including Japanese dance troupe Haru, Australian creative collective The Hairy Godmothers, and the talented young actors from the Australian Shakespeare Company.

To keep things as affordable as possible, ticket prices have been frozen from 2022 (220 Kč when booked in advance) and the popular Prague Fringe Pass is available again which saves the user 20 Kč on each ticket (as well as only paying a single ticket booking fee for your transaction).
