Shortcut #2: Copy Citation from Database

Our **library databases** usually include the MLA citation (often at the end of the article). You can copy and paste this to your Works Cited list, but do check it for mistakes.

Print Book:

Last Name, Firstname. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication. Print.

Magazine/Newspaper

Author(s). "Title of Article." *Title of Periodical* Day Month Year: pages. Medium of publication (Print, Web?).
