

Exiting out hallway exiting out the theatre: Mention the office, accountants and the counsellor room

STATION 1 - UPSTAIRS

Enter centre stairs

On either side we have bathrooms and straight forward, this general area is our social department and our computer lab.

If you can just follow me to the **left side**.

Johnston Heights provides a variety of media including film, digital design, animation, coding and VR design.

(Walk to the end of the hall and inside.) This class in particular is the animation club afterschool, where drawing tablets and adobe animation/illustrators are provided for students to explore their passion for art. Adobe Photoshop is required for many future careers and is taught mandatorily by ADST design in 8th grade

(Exit out through connected classroom)

On the left, we have our socials and english classes, and over here **(right)** we have more computer labs.

(Head out to the RIGHT wing facing balcony and down the stairs)

STATION 2 - BOTTOM FLOOR

Bring down to Ms. Kipps classroom

This is one of our french rooms. Feel free to look around but please don't touch anything.

GIVE THEM 1-2 MINUTES

Walk out, Show the BASES room

This room belongs to BASES students and teachers, as we offer special needs education. Typically, this room is not accessible unless you are working directly with a student

Walk to the science rooms and do a circle from the left side and out into the left classes pointing out the bathrooms briefly

Here we have the science department! At Johnston Heights, hands-on learning is encouraged and students will get to form their own experiments, dissect animals and work with chemicals.

STATION 3 - IB centre

(Go down the hallway on the LEFT)

As previously mentioned, Johnston Heights is the only public school offering both MYP and IBDP to students in this district. Now if you can all follow me, this is the room specifically reserved for IB students and Leadership students to work, study and plan for events.

Walk across to the careers centre

Our school is determined to provide students a good career pathway in terms of post-secondary. If students have any interests in information regarding University entrance, college, or scholarships, this is where they can access all that. Our counsellors are also available to aid in mental health and planning for post secondary, the latter which is predominantly for grade 11 and 12s.

Photocopiers are available at all hours for students to print out assignments. You need to bring your own USB, and colour printing is 25 cents per sheet. Another printer is also available in the learning commons.

Walk out of the IB centre into the library

Station 3.5 LEARNING COMMONS

This is the learning commons.

To borrow books students will receive a student card which gives access to all the schools online resources, and also student discounts (during September). All the important dates and resources are available in your pamphlets, again, more information and to access our school app.

Give parents a few minutes to look around until parents are seen going into the IB centre. Go left into heron lane and through the arts room to go to the cafe without interference of parents in the hall

walk into left hall through art room and out into textiles

STATION 4 - CAFETERIA

Our lunch is prepared by our cafeteria students which is offered as an elective to older grades.

In the cafeteria, the average cost ranges from 3-10 dollars. Many students also choose to eat lunch in their classrooms, or go out to the many stores nearby such as T&T, 711, Palmyra, Bubble World, or Subway. Before we move on, does anyone have any questions?

STATION 5 - Gym to dance to workshops

- **Point to bathrooms**

Unlike elementary, highschool students are required to change into gym clothes before class, which counts for grades. We do have changing rooms inside, but many students also choose to change in the bathrooms. Teachers will give more information specific to their class the first week. All the upcoming important dates are available in your pamphlet.

Walk into the gym through the main entrance exiting the band room

This is what Johnston Heights' gym looks like, and students are encouraged to take part in sports even if they hadn't before.
