Important Homecoming Ticket Information

The IG Center does have a capacity limit, which means *not everyone who wants a ticket will be able to get one*. We do our best to fit as many people as possible, but once we reach that limit, ticket sales will close. We strongly encourage you to **buy tickets on time** to guarantee your spot. Unfortunately, we will not be able to make exceptions once we sell out. Thank you for understanding as we work to make this a safe and fun event for everyone!

How much is a ticket and where can I buy tickets?

Sales for Jr's & Sr's start September 29th at 6pm

Sales for ALL GRADES start September 30th 6pm - UNTIL SELL OUT

Tickets are \$20 each

They will be sold **ONLY** online. Please see our website for the link coming soon.

Tickets are first-come-first-serve and are expected to sell out by October 1st at the latest. All grades are welcome. Juniors and Seniors may buy tickets for **ONLY** Juniors and Seniors during the 1 day priority sale.

Each student must purchase their own ticket. 2 tickets cannot be purchased by a single student. ONLY IRCHS Seniors may bring a guest from another school. * If a Senior student would like to bring a guest, please see the policy below for bringing a guest:

We have reserved a select number of tickets for guests.

To ensure a **safe and enjoyable event** for everyone, we must **limit guest tickets to Seniors only**.

We know this may be disappointing, but with our larger student body, this step is necessary to make sure as many IRCHS students as possible can attend while keeping the event safe and within venue limits.

A guest is considered: a student who attends another school, [guest forms for students outside of IRCHS can be found here](#) - Please note: the potential guest should be a recent graduate, a current high school student, or the homeschool equivalent, not older than the age of 20. ONLY IRCHS Seniors may bring a guest from another school.

If a Senior wishes to purchase a guest ticket, they must submit a guest form. All approved guest forms submitted to the front office by the deadline of Thursday September 25th by 2pm will be entered into the lottery and chosen at random. Forms with missing information will be considered void and not entered into the lottery. *If the guest is approved, the student will be notified by September 28th, and will receive instructions on purchasing the guest ticket ***if approved.***

Remember, this form does include a photo ID. Tickets are first come first serve and you are not allowed to buy a ticket for a guest unless the form has been fully filled out and approved by the other person's school AND IRCHS Admin.

AGAIN, guest forms are due to the front office no later than Thursday, September 25th by 2pm - no exceptions

Please note, that having your guest form approved does not guarantee the student a ticket - the student must first purchase their own ticket and then use the guest ticket code to purchase a ticket.

What is the dress code for homecoming?

This is a formal event.

Dresses should be appropriate, strapless is allowed. The dress does not have to be in "dress code" BUT should be appropriate and cover all areas comfortably. Use your best judgment & come see Ms. Strazzulla or Mrs. Newcomb if you have specific questions. Skirts/ nice pants are fine.

No jeans are allowed. If you are wearing pants, you should wear nice pants and a nice, button-up shirt with a tie or bow tie.

No T-shirt or casual polo shirts. Again, NO JEANS.

You must wear appropriate shoes, no flip-flops or sneakers! (use your best judgment, this is flexible depending on the shoe) Oxfords and dress loafers are acceptable.

What if I would like to run for homecoming court? (Queen, King, Princess, or Prince)

Nomination form TBA.

The court nomination will take place October 6th - 10th. The official court will be announced on October 13th during homebase. The Vote for the Winners will take place October 13th - October 17th with the winner being announced on October 18th at the dance. Your homecoming court posters MUST BE APPROVED by Ms. Amelia Strazzulla and/or Mrs. Tabitha Newcomb before you hang them. Hanging posters before they are approved will result in demerits and disqualification of running for the court. Go ahead & hang your approved posters starting on October 3rd. No earlier.

If you are NOT nominated, you must remove all posters starting the 13th or you will receive demerits (please recycle!)

Here are the rules for court:

- ONLY Seniors can win King or Queen
- ONLY Juniors can win Princess or Prince
- If you win Homecoming Princess or Prince as a Junior, you can NOT win homecoming King or Queen as a Senior
- If you win Homecoming Princess or Prince as a Junior, you can NOT win prom prince or princess as a Senior
- If you win Homecoming Queen or King as a Senior, you can NOT win prom King or Queen as a Senior
- If you would like to put up flyers, you may do so. They MUST all be taken down by Monday, October 20th.
- Your homecoming court posters MUST BE APPROVED by Ms. Amelia Strazzulla and/or Mrs. Tabitha Newcomb before you hang them. You MUST be in IRCHS dresscode on your poster. You will be allowed to hang 10 posters total.
- You MAY NOT send mass emails to students/teachers to promote yourself. **If you attempt to send a mass email, you will be disqualified from running.**
- **Do not remove anyone's nomination poster. Doing so will result in disqualification and/or disciplinary consequences.**
- If you were not elected to the homecoming court during the nomination round, you must take your flyers down by October 13th after homebase to avoid confusion.
- Please ask permission before hanging in a teacher's classroom / on their doors or windows

Additional Information:

- We will have 2 law enforcement officers on the premises for the safety of our students.
- If you leave the event space, you will not be allowed to reenter the building.
- Doors open promptly at 6:45pm, no early admittance will be allowed.
- Snacks will be served, but dinner is not served during homecoming
- Professional photos will be available to purchase after the event. If you do not wish to purchase these photos, please ask the photographers to take 1 photo with your cell phone. No more than one, please. Please note, money from photos purchased will benefit the yearbook program here at IRCHS. They cost no money to take but you will need to pay for them if you wish to order.
- You do NOT need your physical ticket, your name is put on a list when you purchase your ticket
- If you wish to give/transfer your ticket to another person, you will need to transfer your ticket inside of the school cashier's office
