USE OF DATA IN SCHOOL COUNSELING

#1: Data, Data, Data (15 clock hours)

This course introduces you to using data to design, implement, evaluate, and improve their comprehensive school counseling programs.

#2: It's All About TIME (15 clock hours)

This course teaches you evidence-based strategies for maximizing their time in role-appropriate ways to benefit students and support building leaders' goals.
