Supply List

Baby Lock Serger in good working condition
All tools and manuals
Basic Sewing Supplies

This list is for one box. There will be time to make multiple boxes

2 squares cotton fabric, one inside and one outside, 6", 8" or 10" or larger. Pieces larger than 10" may need a firmer batting or stabilizer like Bosal Soft and Stable. (bring enough for two or three boxes)
Stabilizer like Shape Flex or Bosal Soft and Stable.
2 spools Decorative thread, King Tut, Wonderfil 12 wt. etc.
One spool serger thread to match
Fabric marker
Optional
4 Buttons Or beads for each side
Small piece fusible $\frac{1}{4}$ " Steam a Seam to tack down sides

October 8 – Zipper bag w/bow

Zipper bag with bow supply list
Cording foot
2 pcs – 16" x 11" one outside one lining
Zipper 22 " to 24"
2 pcs – 11" x 2" contrasting fabric for bow decorative threads will show on edges 2 pcs – 16" x 11" shape flex can be ironed on at home
4 serger threads
Optional – tow spools decorative threads for edge of bow, one spool could be poly yarn

November 12 – Box Bag

These fun little bags can be made almost any size. Use them for shoe storage in your luggage or to store items in your drawers or sewing room.

Supply List

Serger in good working condition

Manuals and tools

Basic Sewing Supplies

Cording Foot

2 cotton fabric pieces for outside 13" x 9"

2 cotton fabric pieces for lining 13" x 9"

18" or longer plastic zipper

1 cotton piece 2 ¼" x 7" for tabs or 2 pieces cotton 2 ¼" x 7" for handles

2 pieces Shape Flex Fusible interfacing 13" x 9"

4 spools Serger thread to match fabric

Optional: 4" or larger clear ruler

Quilt clips instead of pins
