What do I get if I sign up for the meal plan?

It also means it is easier to make accommodations for dietary needs. They also have internships at the farm for students with disabilities transitioning from high

school. The dining hall will allow for discussions with both indoor and outdoor eating options.

Signing up for the meal plan for the full week (\$200) includes all meals Monday-through-Thursday, including the closing dinner on Thursday evening. There also will be snacks available during breaks.
