Be it resolved by the Northeastern Student of Color Caucus General Assembly that the International Student Advocacy Committee shall abide by the following stipulations:

Article I

In accordance with Constitution Article V the Secretariat shall maintain the right to call Caucus Committees; this committee shall report to the Secretary of Programs. Be it resolved that:

- I. The Caucus hereby creates an International Student Advocacy Committee tasked with the following operations:
 - A. Drafting Resolutions advocating on behalf of the international student population
 - B. Developing the most effective metrics for assessing the overall well-being and success rates of international students versus their domestic student peers. These metrics are likely to include:
 - 1. Percentage of on-campus employment opportunities open to students with international status
 - 2. Analysis of the overall process students with international status face when transitioning to a university setting in the United States

A resolution is a document that outlines the Caucus's current position on any given matter and our plans to address said matter. Once approved, the Caucus abides by the agreement made in a Resolution. Agreements made in Resolutions can be changed simply by passing another Resolution changing the previous agreement.



- 3. Tracking the number of persons of color and number of persons who have immigrated to the U.S. working in the Office of Global Services
- 4. The percentage of students with international status who feel that they are included in an existing cultural community at Northeastern (i.e. cultural centers, cultural student orgs, etc.)
- 5. Other metrics as deemed appropriate by the Committee Members
- C. Proposing programming initiatives to address the findings of the Committee
- II. The International Student Advocacy Committee shall be open to Caucus Members with international student status only in order to best include the international student experience into the Committee's work.
