Ambassadors will earn **American Heart Association CPR certification** and also fulfill the requirements for their **Girl Scout First Aid Badge**. Please note: The **American Heart Association First Aid certification** is not included for Girl Scout Ambassadors, as their badge requirements focus on more advanced, outdoor and wilderness-related first aid skills that do not align with the standard AHA First Aid curriculum.

****Adults wishing to be certified in First Aid and CPR may attend the Seniors class session.****
