Listen

1. Choose one of the stories below about people who have had to leave their home country because of danger.
2. Listen to the story and take notes as you listen using the [DBI organizer](#).
3. After listening, complete the [5Ws organizer](#) to help you summarize the story.

Pair

4. Pair up with someone who listened to a different story. Take turns sharing a summary of the story you heard, using your notes on the 5Ws . Use this sentence starter: The story I heard was about...
5. Work together using a [Venn diagram organizer](#) to note what is particular to each story and what is common to both stories. You can include details and big ideas.

Share

6. Share what you included in your pair’s Venn diagram with the whole class.
7. As a class, discuss common themes across stories noted by multiple pairs.
