Former Superior Lieutenant Governor Solomon Dewey hints at return to politics, decries nationwide "death" of civic engagement

Former Superior Lieutenant Governor Solomon Dewey may be looking to bring his brand of no holds barred politics back to life.

Avon, IN, SP – Last seen running for U.S. Senate, a familiar face yearns to be back in the big picture.

Solomon Dewey, known for his inconsistent party affiliation and public spats with every politician that looked in his direction, has expressed to local Superior Democratic Party leaders that he wants to make a comeback, according to sources. It is also said that Dewey “decried a ‘nationwide death of civic engagement’” and wanted to make such claim a focal point of his return.

Voter records indicated that Dewey is registered as an independent, and some Democratic leaders have made clear their intent to block a possible return. In his last stint with the Party, the firebrand won close election to one of the open Deputy Chair positions just to resign soon after.

Appetite for a return among Superior voters has yet to be seen, although the former Lieutenant Governor has a reputation for strong margins in his previous elections.
