## FIND YOUR ELECTION DAY ASSIGNMENT HERE! PAID OR VOLUNTEER

Working Families Party needs volunteers on election day - **report to the office tomorrow at 276 S 60th St after 10am**. WFP will slot volunteers and send them to polls.

Make the Road PA has 400 positions available for paid and unpaid work on election day in Philadelphia, Allentown, and Reading. You must sign up by October 30 and attend training on November 1. Workers outside Philadelphia should have a car and Spanish language fluency is a plus but not required. TurnPABlue needs 400 volunteers on election day for voter protection activities outside the polls and for poll watchers inside the polling place. Placements are available across the state. [Sign up here.](#)

## ELECTION PROTECTION VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

**Election Protection Volunteer - non-lawyers:** The **ACLU** and **Common Cause** are coordinating election day voter protection work. Sign up for shifts to monitor polling places and assist voters, and to monitor social media. [Sign up here.](#)

**Election Protection - Lawyers.** ACLU-PA is looking for lawyers across the state (outside Allegheny, Dauphin and Philadelphia) to be available to go to court on election day on behalf of voters. **Poll watchers** - Poll watchers play an important role monitoring polling places on election day on behalf of party organizations or candidates for office. They ensure eligible voters can cast ballots and prevent electioneering in the polling location. To apply, reach out directly to the campaign of your preferred candidate, or your county's political party organization.
