Title of the Research Paper: Period Poverty: A Case Study of Little Red Hood

Becky, Chang. Section C. Period poverty is a public health, social, and educational issue that affects millions of females worldwide, including in Taiwan. The issue refers to two aspects in Taiwan: one is that there is indeed a group of females who cannot obtain supplies that can properly handle menstruation due to economic factors. The other is that due to the long-term lack of appropriate resources and education, menstruation is not emphasized in sex education in the Taiwanese educational system. This study includes both questionnaires (quantitative data) and interviews (qualitative data) to investigate Taiwanese college students' acknowledgment of period poverty, including the government's policy of providing free sanitary products on campus, improving period education in schools, and Little Red Hood's action in ending period poverty. The results of the study aim to promote awareness of the period poverty issue on campus and hope to further encourage the implementation of the government's policy to improve the situation of period poverty in Taiwan.
