

Introducing MiStrategyBank

What is MiStrategyBank?

The MSB is an electronic clearinghouse of strategies designed to connect educational data systems, promote and support best practices, and provide information regarding the implementation of strategies in use to support Michigan's education system. This application is being used by MICIP to integrate the strategy selection process within the MICIP platform.

How was MiStrategyBank developed?

MiStrategyBank was developed by a group of Michigan educators in the spring of 2019 to support MiREAD. The use of MiStrategyBank expanded to include connections to MICIP and other support systems for educators. Michigan Association of Intermediate School Administrators (MAISA) and Michigan Collaboration Hub (MiCH) worked with a team of ISD software developers, using the Actionable Data Advisory for ongoing feedback on the system.

How do I select the right strategy?

MiStrategyBank can connect users to an electronic clearinghouse of strategies that can be filtered by:
