## -ABILL-

## TO APPROVE THE 2025-2026 FISCAL BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 144th SENATE OF THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA.

**Section 1.** The Senate finds and declares the following:

- a) The total proposed budget for the Undergraduate Student Government shall be two million four hundred eighty-three thousand four-hundred fifty-six dollars (\$2,483,456).
- b) The account currently titled "Bystander Intervention Training (DEIB)" shall be renamed to "Inclusive Impact Programming Fund."
- c) Amendments to this budget shall be approved by the Senate, as required by the Bylaws.

**Section 2.** Each account of the Undergraduate Student Government shall be given an appropriation in the amount specified below:

- a) to the Student Stipends Account, three hundred seventy-five thousand seven hundred dollars (\$375,700);
- b) to Staff Salaries, sixty-six thousand dollars (\$66,000);
- c) to the Office of Student Basic Needs, fifty-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$55,500)
- d) to Campus Activities, nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$9,500);
- e) to the Recreational Club Council, one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000);
- f) to the Administration Account, twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000);
- g) to the Development Account, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000);
- h) to the Executive Account, forty-six thousand dollars (\$46,000);

- i) to the Legislative Account, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000);
- j) to the Inclusive Impact Programming Fund, three thousand dollars (\$3,000);
- k) to Legal Services, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000);
- 1) to the Communications Account, four thousand dollars (\$4,000);
- m) to the Performing & Visual Arts and Cultural Funds, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000);
- n) to the Professional and Academic Research Funds, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000);
- o) to the Philanthropy Fund, fifty thousand one hundred dollars (\$50,000);
- p) to the Social & Recreation and Startup Funds, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000);
- q) to the Academic Culture Assembly, thirty thousand four hundred dollars (\$30,400);
- r) to the Asian Pacific American Student Assembly, eighty-two thousand three hundred dollars (\$82,300);
- s) to the Black Student Assembly, seventy-three thousand seven hundred dollars (\$73,700);
- t) to the Environmental Student Assembly, thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000);
- u) to the First Generation Student Assembly, fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000);
- v) to the International Student Assembly, forty-nine thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$49,250);
- w) to the Joint Assembly for Military-Associated Students, twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000);
- x) to the Latine Student Assembly, seventy-six thousand one hundred dollars (\$76,100);
- y) to the Middle Eastern North African Student Assembly, twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000);
- z) to the Native American Student Assembly, fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000);
- aa) to the Political Student Assembly, eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000);
- bb) to the Queer and Ally Student Assembly, forty-nine thousand dollars (\$49,000);
- cc) to the Student Assembly for Accessibility, three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500);
- dd) to the Student Assembly for Gender Empowerment, fifty-seven thousand dollars (\$57,000);
- ee) to the Transfer Student Assembly, fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000);
- ff) to the Undocumented Student Success Assembly, eleven thousand five hundred dollars (\$11,500)
- gg) to the Concerts Committee, four hundred ninety-five thousand dollars (\$495,000);
- hh) to the Performing Arts Committee, forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000);
- ii) to the Speakers Committee, eighty-three thousand dollars (\$83,000);
- jj) to the Trojan Pride Committee, seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000);
- kk) to the Senate Allocations Reserves, one thousand dollars (\$1,000);
- ll) and to the Elections Account, seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that within **3 days (72 hours)** of being passed by the Undergraduate Student Government Senate, this resolution be delivered by Parliamentary Secretary Luisa Luo to the President of the Undergraduate Student Government, Brianna Sanchez for signature,
