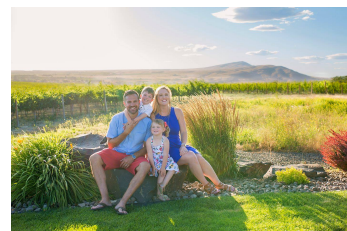
Welcome!
